

Admission for Students with BA/BS in other Academic Disciplines

In spring, the graduate program in speech-language pathology may accept a limited number of highly qualified students with undergraduate degrees in other disciplines. These students begin their program in fall by taking undergraduate prerequisite courses. The entire course of study is 30-36 months in length. Those wishing for public school certification may take 36 months. Below is a sample program. Several variations are possible. Undergraduate prerequisite courses are boldfaced.
