

TRANSPORTATION SAFETY NET SCENARIOS

Students living in Geneseo, like other residents, have unanticipated needs that arise 24/7. These transportation safety net scenarios are for those “unexpected” occurrences over which no one has control. SCENARIO – STUDENT HAS BEEN TRANSPORTED TO HOSPITAL AND NEEDS A RIDE HOME.

1. Weekday release from local hospitals during the day. (See last bullet for 24/7 transport by taxi.)

- **From Noyes Memorial in Dansville via public bus service:**

LIVINGSTON AREA TRANSPORTATION SERVICE: LATS can assist during weekday hours. Although a business day’s notice is normally required, the student can mention the doctor’s release requirements – call LATS at 585-658-4690 and confirm cost. Dial-a-ride services will cost \$2.00 between towns (Dansville to Geneseo) or \$1.00 within town to arrive at location of fixed route service. County fixed route service is free with SUNY Geneseo ID.

- **From Noyes Memorial in Dansville via taxis:** Local service is usually more cost effective, but inquire from hospital staff first.

- **From Noyes Memorial in Dansville and Wyoming County Community Health System in Warsaw:**

Current rates between Geneseo and Noyes in Dansville or Geneseo and Wyoming in Warsaw are \$40 one-way.

- **When none of the above are available, Century Transportation, Inc. can be called 24/7.**

Students can pay at the time of service or have the service billed to their College Student Account.*

*SUNY Geneseo has an agreement with Century Cab so that the company can provide a ride even when a student is stranded without funds. The student must show ID, sign for service and the student’s college account will be billed. *(This bill should be paid promptly because a hold will be placed on the student’s record).*

2. Release from local urban area hospitals.

- **From Strong Memorial, Highland or Rochester General hospitals in Rochester:
Taxis will be the most common unless a special ride can be arranged via volunteers.**

SCENARIO – STUDENT NEEDS A RIDE FROM CAMPUS TO A MEDICAL APPOINTMENT.

Please contact transport@geneseo.edu for advice when preparing to set up appointments - planning ahead is helpful. Note that the bus routes are not numerous and walking will be involved. Consider asking the professional office for advice about any other transportation that might be available.

1. Appointment is in Rochester at Strong Health, Clinton Crossings area or Highland Hospital.

- **For appointments on Tuesday and Thursdays:** Call Transportation Services several days before at 585-245-5123 or email transport@geneseo.edu so arrangements can be made with LATS. This is a limited time frame (appointments at Strong between 9 and 11:30 a.m. and at Highland between 9:30 and 11 a.m.). Cost is \$17.00 RT to accommodate dial-a-ride (\$2.00 each direction) and cost to Rochester (\$6.50 each direction).
- **For a volunteer driver** contact the Northern Livingston County Red Cross at least one week in advance to see if a driver is available. Payment is requested at \$20.00 RT. Call 585-243-7029 or email nlccross@frontiernet.net. Catholic Charities *Faith in Action Program* is another possibility; contact Christa Barrows at 585-658-4466 x18.
- **If nothing above applies**, call Century Transportation, Inc. at 585-235-7777 and ask for quote (probably \$170 RT). Students can pay at the time of service or have the service billed to their Student Account (that must be paid promptly).

2. Appointment is in professional offices near Genesee Community College, Lakeville campus.

- **LATS has only fixed route service available (free with SUNY Genesee ID):** Bus leaves Genesee Mobil at Main & 20A at 8:55 a.m. and arrives Western Mini-Mart (near McDonalds) in Lakeville at 9:20 a.m. Bus returns from Lakeville at 1:55 p.m. and arrives in Genesee at 2:15 p.m. Call LATS at 585-658-4690 to confirm.
- **For a volunteer driver** contact the Northern Livingston County Red Cross at least one week in advance to see if a driver is available. Payment is requested at \$10.00 RT. Call 585-243-7029 or email nlccross@frontiernet.net. Catholic Charities *Faith in Action Program* is another possibility; contact Christa Barrows at 585-658-4466 x18.
- **If nothing above applies**, call Century Transportation, Inc. at 585-235-7777 and ask for quote. Students can pay at the time of service or have the service billed to their Student Account (that must be paid promptly).

3. Appointment is in Genesee at the Livingston Health Services on Lakeville Road (Route 20A).

- **The Genesee Public Bus Service offered via LATS is available (free with SUNY Genesee ID):** One can also call LATS at 585-658-4690 in advance to arrange pick-up if a Dial-a-Ride bus is available (this service is \$1.00 OW).

SCENARIO – STUDENT ARRIVES AT AIRPORT, BUS OR TRAIN STATION AFTER SCHEDULED BUS PICK-UP.

1. Airport 24/7

- **Advance Airport Taxi Service:** Go to the taxicab starter booth in front of the main terminal's center entrance. The quote is at least \$85, phone 585-235-3333.
- **Century Transportation, Inc.:** Call Century at 585-235-7777; current quote is \$85 OW. Students can pay at the time of service or have the service billed to their Student Account (that must be paid promptly).

2. Airport – daytime and early evenings

- **Able Express Transportation:** Call 585-663-1600 before 11 p.m.; current quote is \$75.

3. Bus or train station – 24/7

- **Century Transportation, Inc.:** Call Century at 585-235-7777; current quote is \$85 OW. Students can pay at the time of service or have the service billed to their Student Account (that must be paid promptly).

4. Bus or train station – daytime and early evenings

- **Able Express Transportation:** Call 585-663-1600 before 11 p.m.; current quote is \$80.
