Middlebury Leads First 2011-12 Division III Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings; NESCAC Places Three Institutions in the Top Five

CLEVELAND – Middlebury (Vt.) leads in the first fall Division III Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings with 295.00 points. The Panthers earned their point totals with second place finishes in both women's cross country and field hockey, ninth in volleyball and a 13th place finish in men's cross country.

Washington University (Mo.) is in second place with 249.00 points. The Bears scored in three of four championships, finishing first in women's cross country, third in men's cross country, and ninth in volleyball.

In third place with 178.00 points is **Bowdoin (Maine)**. The Polar Bears finished in third place in field hockey, 15th in men's cross country and 17th in volleyball.

Rounding out the top five is **Calvin (Mich.)** and **Williams (Mass.)**. The Calvin Knights scored in three championships, volleyball (ninth), men's cross country (11th) and women's cross country (13th). The Williams Ephs scored a third place finish in women's cross country and a sixth place showing in men's cross country.

The **New England Small College Athletic Conference** is leading the way with three of its institutions currently in the top five. Following current leader Middlebury (Vt.) is Bowdoin (Maine) in third and Williams (Mass.) in fifth.

To date, four fall NCAA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: women's cross country - Washington (Mo.); men's cross country - North Central (Il.); field hockey - The College of New Jersey; volleyball - Wittenberg (Ohio).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and USA Today. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 18 sports -- nine women's and nine men's.

The next Division III fall standings will be released Thursday, December 8.

Please note, standings published midseason are unofficial. Official standings will be published upon the completion of the spring season.
