Geneseo is a public liberal arts college and is the most selective among the SUNY comprehensive colleges. A distinguished faculty characterized by National and SUNY teaching awards instructs students with outstanding high school records resulting in an 79% college graduation rate. Recent national recognition includes Phi Beta Kappa Chapter (first among the SUNY comprehensive colleges) and accreditation by the International Association for Management Education. Kiplinger ranked Geneseo No. 2 best value among the nation's public colleges and universities for out-of-state students. In the U.S. News College Rankings, Geneseo ranked 11th out of 84 institutions in the Best Universities-Masters for the northern region and 2nd among the Top Public Universities-Masters for the northern region.
