DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: THEATRE

1. Minimum competence (grade of C- or better) required in all required courses, including common, elective, and focus courses.
2. Electives should be selected under advisement from Danc 211, Thea 204, 224, 225, 233, 234, 235, 236, 290, 310, 320, 321, 330, 333, 342, 343, 344, 345, 346, 347, 390, 399.
3. Proficiency in a foreign language is strongly recommended. Majors should consult departmental advisors regarding specifics relating to foreign language study.
4. A maximum of 51 semester hours in Theatre and maximum of 60 hours in Theatre and Dance may be included within the required 120. At least 69 hours must be completed outside of the Theatre department. At least 60 hours must be completed out of the Theatre and Dance departments combined.
5. Three semester hours of Theatre Practicum (Thea 260); 1 credit in acting, 2 credits in technical/costume assistance, or 3 credits in technical/costume assistance.
6. Majors must complete the department writing requirement – see College Bulletin.
