## **DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: THEATRE/ENGLISH**

- 1. Minimum competence (grade of C- or better) required in all Theatre and in all English courses submitted in fulfillment of the major.
- 2. An audition is required for admission to the Major In Theatre/English: two memorized monologues, two to three minutes in length, one serious and one comic (no period requirement); applicants also may be requested to perform an improvisation; résumé.
- 3. Students majoring in this interdisciplinary major may use appropriate Theatre an English courses to satisfy both requirements of the major and general education requirements.
- 4. Sixteen hours of English must be at the 300-level. This fulfills the Departmental Writing Requirement.
- 5. Students seeking provisional certification at the secondary level in English must enroll in the appropriate certification program in the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and Reading. Information sheets are available in the School of Education. These students must also complete an additional 6 hours of English.
- 6. Majors are strongly urged to study a foreign language through a minimum of one 300-level course.
- 7. A minimum of 69 semester hours outside of ENGL must be completed.
- 8. Majors must contact the Dean of the School of Arts concerning the required writing requirement.
