A formal report of a sexual misconduct has been submitted to the Dean of Students



Contact is made by the DOS/ADOS with complainant to explore options for addressing the sexual misconduct. The complainant can choose to do nothing, or proceed through the Student Code of Conduct, file a Title IX grievance, and/or file charges with law enforcement on campus and/or in the off-campus community. (Off-campus community law enforcement may require that campuses delay their proceedings if a criminal case is pending)



LEVEL 1 (1:1 Review)

Accused student is informed of the complaint.



Accused student meets with the Dean of Students or Assistant Dean (Complainant does not attend the review).



The Dean of Students or Assistant Dean of Students determines the outcome and determines sanctions if applicable.



The complainant and accused student are informed of the outcome in writing within 5 busines days.



LEVEL 2 (Student Conduct Board)

Accused student is informed of the complaint



Conduct review is held with the Student Conduct Board (Witnesses may be called by both parties; complainant required to participate in person or by alternative means; both compainant and accused may attend with an advisor.)



Student Conduct Board determines the outcome, reviews prior history or current conduct status of the accused and determines sanctions.



The complainant and accused student are informed of the outcome in writing within 5 business days...
