All SUNY-Geneseo internal funding programs are administered by the Office of Sponsored Research and applications to its programs are reviewed by the Research Council or one of its subcommittees.

*Applications and proposals for grants and contracts to external agencies, foundations, and companies must be submitted through the Office of Sponsored Research. Grant funds are administered through the Research Foundation of SUNY according to Board of Trustees policy.*

## FACULTY SUMMER FELLOWSHIPS

**Presidential Summer Fellowships** provide new faculty with an opportunity to participate in creative activities or to establish an ongoing research program. It is expected that the result of this fellowship work will form the basis, in some disciplines, for a larger project for which external funds are eventually sought. *Tenure track faculty employed five or fewer years at the College, and who are returning for the following year, are eligible. Prior recipients of this award are not eligible.* The \$3,500 awards are funded by an allocation from the President. Recipients who submit a grant proposal to an external agency, within one year of the fellowship period, will receive an additional \$500 award for research expenses. *Application deadline is January 25, 2013.*

**Geneseo Foundation Summer Faculty Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Faculty Fellowship** support the research and creative projects of Geneseo faculty who are tenured. These fellowships are intended to enable completion of a significant project or to embark in a new direction. It is expected that the scholarly progress of this work, in some disciplines, will lead to external funding. Faculty members become eligible for the Geneseo Foundation Summer Faculty Fellowship and Roemer Summer Faculty Fellowship if they have been awarded tenure (i.e. they have received formal notification from the President). *Five years must elapse (application to application) before previous summer fellowship recipients are eligible.* Applications for the Geneseo Foundation Summer Faculty Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Faculty Fellowship will be considered in one pool. The highest-ranked application will be awarded the \$5,000 Roemer Summer Faculty Fellowship and the next highest-ranked applications will be awarded the \$4,000 Geneseo Foundation Summer Faculty Fellowships. The awards may be used for a stipend and/or support for expenses. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation and by an endowment gift to the Geneseo Foundation from the late Dr. Spencer Roemer. *Application deadline is January 25, 2013.*

## RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT AND SCHOLARLY SUPPORT

**Proposal Writing Support Awards** provide full-time faculty members with time and other forms of support to write major proposals for submission to external funding agencies. Faculty members may request a course release or other funding to support the writing of either: 1) new proposals, or 2) significant revisions of previously submitted proposals. Support will be considered for major proposals in all academic fields and for a variety of initiatives (e.g. fellowships, research grants, educational grants). A "major" proposal is defined as one requesting a total of \$15,000 or more in support from the sponsor. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation. *Application deadlines are September 7, 2012, and January 18, 2013.*

**CIEE International Faculty Development Summer Seminar Award** supports the participation of one member of our faculty in a summer seminar of their choosing as offered annually by the the Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE) through its International Faculty Development Seminar (IFDS) program. Details on the IFDS program and seminar offerings for the upcoming summer may be found on the CIEE IFDS web site: <http://www.ciee.org/ifds/> The CIEE IFD Summer Seminar Award will provide \$5,000 towards the cost of the seminar fee, the application fee, international transportation, and other expenses related to the seminar. The awardee will be responsible for expenses in excess of the \$5,000 award. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation. *Application Deadline, September 7, 2012.*

**Research Development Awards** provide support for a wide variety of needs associated with developing research and scholarly projects leading to proposals to external sponsors. Funds may be requested for equipment, supplies, software, services, or research assistants. Maximum award is \$1,000 or release time from one course. Funded by the College. *Application deadlines are September 7, 2012 and January 18, 2013.*

**Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty initiatives in research and fund pilot studies, completion of manuscripts, data analyses, bibliographic or archival searches, and creative work. Travel to archives, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000 but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the costs of involving a student in the proposed project (maximum award of \$1,500). Funded by the Geneseo Foundation. *Application deadlines are May 11, 2012, September 7, 2012, January 18, 2013. The first deadline of the 2013-14 year is May 10, 2013.*

**Research Discretionary Allocations** support activities leading directly to external fundable projects. Funding is provided for expenses connected with the development of proposals including communication and travel to meet with sponsor representatives and for other costs of research development. Funded by an allocation from the President. *Application is at any time by contacting the Director of Sponsored Research.*

**Indirect Costs Return Awards** return part of the indirect costs, recovered the previous year, to the principal investigator or project director. These funds are to be used for research expenses not covered by budgeted costs. *Allocation made on the basis of the amount of indirect costs recovered.*

**Page Charge** allocations cover some costs of faculty publications in journals with mandatory page or reprint charges. *Request from the Director of Sponsored Research when needed.*

**Matching Funds** for various grant programs are arranged through the department chair and the Office of the Provost. Project directors are advised to make arrangements for matching funds well in advance of the application deadline.

## TRAVEL PROGRAMS

**Faculty Travel Grants** are awarded to formal participants at professional meetings, conferences, showings, or performances. Participation is defined as presenting a paper or poster, organizing a session, serving as a discussant, or giving an invited performance or gallery showing. Requests for other forms of conference participation must be accompanied by a justification and will be evaluated based on the degree to which they disseminate scholarly work. Maximum total annual award (for the summer-fall-spring year cycle) is \$800 for presentations within the U.S. (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and \$1,000 for travel to Hawaii or outside the U.S./Canada. Travel to CONDUCT research is not funded by this program (see Incentive Grants, below). Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.

*Application deadlines are May 11, 2012 (for summer 2012 travel – i.e. travel occurring after June 1<sup>st</sup>), September 7, 2012 (for fall travel), January 18, 2013 (for spring travel). The first deadline for the 2013-14 travel year is May 10, 2013 (for summer 2013 travel).*

**Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty and graduate student initiatives in research. Travel for research to archives, museums, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000 but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the costs of involving a student in the proposed project (maximum award of \$1,500). Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.

*Application deadlines are May 11, 2012, September 7, 2012, January 18, 2013. The first deadline of the 2013-14 year is May 10, 2013.*

**Hurrell McNaron Award** is presented to an untenured faculty member, on a tenure track appointment, in support of a paper or comparable project delivered at a major conference of her/his discipline. This award of \$1,000 is in addition to any other travel funds awarded by other Research Council programs. Application is made by checking the appropriate box on the Research Travel Grant form and submitting the specified additional material.

*Application deadline for the complete application package, including additional materials, is February 15, 2013.*

## STUDENT RESEARCH PROGRAMS

**Undergraduate Research and Travel Grants** support student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester (\$1,500 maximum per group). Funded by the Student Association and the Geneseo Foundation.

*Application deadline is September 14, 2012 for Fall 2012 research and travel expenses.*

*Application deadline is November 9, 2012 for Spring 2013 research and travel expenses.*

**Graduate Student Research and Travel Grants** support graduate student research, scholarly, or creative activities, and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. This program is open to full- and part-time graduate students currently enrolled in one of Geneseo's graduate programs. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester (\$1,500 maximum per group). Funded by the College.

*Application deadline is September 14, 2012 for Fall 2012 research and travel expenses.*

*Application deadline is November 9, 2012 for Spring 2013 research and travel expenses.*

*Application deadline is February 1, 2013 for Spring 2013 research and travel expenses.*

**Geneseo Foundation and Follett Higher Education Group Undergraduate Summer Fellowships** provide a \$3,000 stipend for students to undertake a research or creative project under the direction of a faculty member. Recipients must devote two consecutive summer months to their project. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation and Follett Higher Education Group. *Application deadline is February 15, 2013.*

**Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes Research Award** supports student research or field study. Preference will be given to scholarly research combining a natural science and a social science such as biology/sociology or geology/anthropology. Funds may be used for any research-related expenses including student stipends and must be used before the end of the Fall semester. Maximum award is \$600. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes. *Application deadline is April 5, 2013.*

**Dean Johnston Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with paid research assistance for their scholarly projects. Students work with individual professors for ten weeks during the academic year. Students receive a stipend of \$1,000. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by CPAC, Inc.

*Application deadline is October 26, 2012 for Spring 2013 Semester assistantships.*

**Geneseo Foundation Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with paid research assistance for their scholarly projects. Students work with individual professors for ten weeks during the academic year. Students receive a stipend of \$1,000. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.

*Application deadline is April 5, 2013 for Fall 2013 Semester Assistantships.*
