

This is a follow-up to the Sexual Assault Investigation, Case No. 16545, reported on April 13, 2014.

The University Police Department has conducted several interviews. The Department is currently following up on several leads relating to this case. We have increased visibility in the area of Sturges Hall and will be vigilant in our patrols.

No victim is ever to be blamed for being assaulted or abused. However, all Geneseo students are advised to take recommended precautions for avoiding potential attacks in the wake of this report, including:

- Never walk alone, especially at night
- Be mindful of or reduce the consumption of alcohol. Students under the influence may be targeted as victims. Remember: intoxicated students are not in a position to provide affirmative consent for sexual activity.
- Pay close attention to your surroundings at all times
- Walk in well-lighted areas
- Whenever possible use the LATS public bus
- Know the locations of the Blue Light Emergency Phones
- Contact the University Police Department to request a safety escort
