












Facilities Services Wastes

Parts Cleaner solvent	Solvent Haz. Waste F003	Must be kept in closed, labeled, fire-rated containers in room where waste is generated.	 Contract with Recycling Service (may treat as Hazardous Waste)
Antifreeze (ethylene glycol)	Not Hazardous Waste unless contaminated by solvents or metals	 Kept in closed, labeled containers in automotive shop.	Segregate and Recycle
Waste Oils and oil filters	Used Oil, Not Haz Waste unless contaminated by solvents or metals	 Kept in closed, labeled containers in automotive shop.	Segregate and Recycle
Thinners	 Ignitable Haz Waste	Must be kept in closed, labeled, fire-rated containers in room where waste is generated.	Replace with water-based paints. Separate and reuse thinner as "first wash" for brushes. Dispose of unusable portion through Haz. Waste Disposal Firm.
Paints	Heavy metal wastes when liquid	Replace with water-based paints. Purchase only quantities. Store to maintain usability.	
Aerosol Cans	Flammable Haz. Waste, if not empty	Must be completely emptied prior to disposal.	MT Must be completely emptied prior to disposal.
Acids/Bases	Corrosive Haz. Waste 	Must be kept in closed, labeled containers in room where waste is generated. Acids/Bases may be neutralized and liquid with verified pH of >5 but <9 can be drain disposed. Solids must be managed as Haz. Waste. Records of neutralization must be maintained.	Contract for disposal with Haz. Waste Disposal Firm
PCB Light Ballasts	Exempt from Hazardous Waste regulation	Place in bucket, transport to Central Stores. CS personnel will place into closed, labeled drum.	Contract for Recycling/Incineration
Fluorescent Bulbs	Universal Waste (as of 1/6/2000)	Custodians collect and place in original packing containers which have been correctly labeled. Moving Crew relocates to Storage Building for INDOOR storage.	 Recycle (Haz Waste otherwise)
Batteries	Universal Waste	Place in battery recycling (Bailey and Clark Loading Docks, Greene 2nd Floor)	 Recycle (Haz Waste otherwise)
Mercury	Toxic Hazardous Waste D009, U151	Best Option: Don't use Mercury containing products. Must be kept in closed, labeled containers in room where waste is generated.	Best Option: Don't use Mercury containing products. Must be kept in closed, labeled containers in room where waste is generated.
Sharps: Broken glassware, needles, saw blades, etc.	Sharps 	Kept in labeled, puncture resistant containers (a box, marked with "Sharps" and taped shut will suffice.)	Glass may be recycled. Other containerized items can be placed near garbage for disposal.
Compressed Gas Cylinders	Classification based on contents	Keep all cylinders labeled as to contents and supplier.	Do not purchase cylinders. Contract for supply.
