Dear Students:

If you are registered to vote in Geneseo, there will be a **Village Election on Tuesday, March 15th, 2022**. If you are registered to vote outside of Geneseo, contact your Board of Elections for specific information on local elections in your home county. ### **2022 Village Election Information:**

- Check to see if you are registered to vote in Geneseo: [Click here](#).
  - **\*IMPORTANT:** If you are registered to vote outside of Geneseo, you are not eligible to vote in this election.
- On Tuesday, March 15th, 2022, the Village Election will take place from **Noon to 9:00 pm EST**.
- If you plan to be in Geneseo over spring break, **vote in person**. If you are away from Geneseo during spring break, **vote by absentee ballot**.

### **How to Vote:**

#### **\*\*Voting by Absentee Ballot\*\***

- To obtain your absentee ballot, **you must first apply for one**. To complete your Absentee Ballot Application form: [Click here](#).
  - **\*Please note:** New York State requires an excuse for a mail-in ballot instead of sending all residents a mail-in ballot or an application. If you are away from Geneseo during spring break, please indicate “*absence from county or NYS on Election Day*” as the excuse on your absentee ballot application.
- You (the applicant) or an applicant’s agent must deliver all absentee ballot applications to the Livingston County Board of Elections, located in the [Government Building \(6 Court St, Geneseo, NY\)](#).
- The Board of Elections will process absentee ballot applications **Monday- Friday next week (3/7-3/11) from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm**.
- **\*IMPORTANT: Monday, March 14th (3/14)** is the last day for an applicant or applicant’s agent to personally deliver an application for an absentee ballot to the Board of Elections.

#### **\*\*Voting in Geneseo\*\***

- You may vote in person on Tuesday, March 15th, 2022:
  - **Off-campus students:** Depending on your address, you will vote at [St. Mary’s Parish Center \(Precinct 1\), 13 North Street](#), or [United Methodist Church \(Precinct 2\)](#). The election district map for Geneseo is available at this link: [Geneseo Election Districts](#). Or you can call the Board of Elections at (585) 243-7090 to locate your poll site.
  - **On-campus students:** If your voting address is on-campus (Precinct 3), you are assigned to [Alice Austin Theater, Brodie Hall](#). The entrance to the poll site can be found on the corner of Park Street, up the hill from South and Welles Halls.
