

Housing Lottery

General selection: The housing lottery is separated by current class year and then randomized within the class year

LLC selection: Students are separated by terms they have lived on campus, then randomized within the term groups

This system is based on credits. If you disagree with your class standing, contact DAPA or your advisor. Class standing is reported to us and is visible on the first page of the application.

Group Size and Options

Roommate Group Size	Areas
1-person	Single students can select in Steuben or in any space in Upper-Level Community
2-person	Roommate groups of 2 students can select in Steuben or in any space in Upper-Level Community
3-person	As a partial group in any Upper-Level Community 6 or 8 person Suite
4-person	As a partial group in any Upper-Level Community 6 or 8 person Suite
5-person	As a partial group in any Upper-Level Community 6 or 8 person Suite
6-person	Allegany, Erie, Genesee, Ontario, or as a partial group in an Upper-Level Community 8 person suite.
8-person	Allegany, Erie, Genesee, Ontario

Note: Upper-Level Communities are for partia groups that do not fully fill the suite.

When selecting with a group, you will request one another through group selection on Symplicity Residence. You ARE able to change your group leader or disband and reform your group at any time through selection.

Have a housing backup plan! If your original plan does not work out, have at least one other housing option ready for selection. This is especially important for popular spaces and buildings.

Onondaga Hall is an 8 minute walk to South Hall and Ontario is 10 minutes.

Onondaga is 11 minutes from Mama Mia's and Ontario Hall is 12 Minutes.

If you have or regularly use a car, South Village has ample parking in comparison to the limited parking in North and Central Villages.

Residency Requirement and Contract Release

SUNY Geneseo has a two-year residency requirement. All new students at Geneseo are required to live on campus for four consecutive semesters.

Students who have completed their residency requirement are no longer obligated to live on campus. However, once completing an application, students are committing to live on campus for the next academic year, are responsible for room fees, and will need to apply for release with a qualifying reason.

Townhouse Waitlist

The townhouse process has already been completed for the 23/24 academic year. If you have either selected your townhouse or have accepted an offer for the waitlist, you are all set. If you have not and would like to have the opportunity to live in Saratoga next year, please complete the waitlist application located on your Symplicity home page. Offers will be made in the order that they are received. After requesting to be on the waiting list, you are committing to live on campus for next academic year and should select another room in the meantime.





Housing Accommodations

Geneseo recognizes the importance of providing reasonable accommodations in its housing policies and practices where necessary for individuals with disabilities to have equal access to the benefits of oncampus housing.
