VOTE BY MAIL

REQUESTING YOUR BALLOT

Any registered New York voter can request an early mail ballot. Click here to request your early mail ballot before Saturday, March 23, 2024.

RETURNING YOUR BALLOT

You may return your completed ballot in any of four ways:



By mail following the instructions provided with your ballot. In order to be counted, mailed ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, April 2, 2024, and received no later than Tuesday, April 9, 2024.

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

If you've voted in New York before, registered in person, or provided ID at the time of registration, you don't need to show ID to vote.

If you're voting in New York for the first time, registered to vote by mail, and didn't provide ID when you registered, you will be required to show one form of identification, with or without a photograph. Click here to find which forms of identification are accepted.
