To the Campus Community,

The University Police Department has issued a Timely Warning regarding several burglaries reported over the past several days that appear to be related.

A burglary is committed when someone enters a structure without permission to commit or with intent to commit a crime, such as theft.

The University Police Department is currently investigating reports of theft from rooms in Genesee and Wyoming Halls. The thefts were reported to have occurred on November 2 and November 9.

If you believe that you may also have been a victim of a theft, or think you have information relevant to these reports, please contact University Police at 585-245-5651.

Vigilance is an important step in detecting and preventing crime. UPD encourages the community to take the following steps:

- Report suspicious behavior or criminal activity to UPD immediately. If you see something, say something!
 - University Police Emergency: 585-245-5222 or 911
 - University Police Non-emergency: 585-245-5651
 - University Police Anonymous Report Form: Silent Witness Reporting
- Ensure doors are locked and ground-level windows are closed when you are not in your room or office.
- Do not prop exterior doors open.
- Do not open or hold open exterior residence hall doors for people you do not know.
