

Power Strips and Multi-plug adapters

- Extension cords are not permitted for permanent use.
- Multi-plug adapters need to have surge protection and should have a circuit breaker reset switch. If they are surge protection only, be advised they will protect your devices from a sudden power surge and then they would need to be replaced.
- Power Strips & Surge-Suppression devices: Must have overcurrent protection (circuit breaker).
- Power strips and multi-plug adapters need to be UL or Intertek listed.
- They are required to plug directly into a permanent wall outlet.
- Do NOT plug them into each other or daisy chain them.
- Replaced damaged devices and/or cords.
- Cords shall not pass through doors, walls, or ceilings.
- Replace device if the overcurrent indicators, red light, flash sporadically.
- Refrigerators and microwave units need to be plugged directly into a wall outlet.
- The only microwaves allowed in residence halls are the rental units that come with a refrigerator.
- The following are examples of power strips, and multi-plug devices and the rating marks you need to look for prior to purchase.
