










Full-Time Salary Summary





















What is the NACM Core?

The NACM Career Mobility Question Core is a set of items added to the First Destination Survey to gain additional insight into graduates' career-related educational experiences. These questions map to the National Alumni Career Mobility Survey for 5- and 10-year alumni. Research themes from the NACM survey that are found in this section include:


- 1. Influential Career Practices: NACM national research has found several practices that influence an alum's career mobility, such as networking with employers and creating a career plan.
- 2. Return on Investment: Measured through impressions of value of degree, career preparation, and satisfaction.
- 3. Career and Economic Mobility: Measured through satisfaction with career, earning potential, and student loan debt.





Did you receive career advice?




Did you complete an internship or related experience?










