

## **MANAGEMENT MINOR**

**The Management minor is only open to students who have been admitted to the School of Business as a full Accounting, Economics, or Business Administration major. Pre-majors and majors outside the School of Business may not declare a Management minor.**

The Management minor is designed to prepare students for a broad array of careers in management. In-depth study and application provide the knowledge and skills needed to plan, organize, monitor, and lead in organizational settings large and small. Students interested in Human Resources are strongly encouraged to get involved with the student chapter of the Society for Human Resources Management. Students interested in entrepreneurship should contact the Director of the VentureWorks program for additional information and pursue the two INTD electives.

MGMT 347 Special Topics in Personnel and Human Resources (3) Prerequisite: MGMT 346

MGMT 395 Internship (3) Prerequisites: 2.75 cum GPA, Jr. / Sr. standing, permission of Internship Director

INTD 325 Entrepreneurship: Commercial Ideation (3) Fall only, Prerequisite: junior standing

INTD 425 Entrepreneurship: Ideas2Venture (3) Spring only, Prerequisite: Jr. / Sr. standing and INTD 325

#### **Internship Note:**

Students who choose MGMT 395, Internship, for one of the Management minor elective courses must have a management internship. The learning activities and experience must be approved **prior to starting** the internship. No student will be permitted to get credit for a past internship (after the fact) in fulfillment of the Management minor.

#### **Program Notes:**

- Students majoring in Business Administration **may not** count any of the courses taken for the Management minor toward the Business Administration major electives.
- Students should note of all related MATH, ACCT, ECON, FNCE, MGMT, and MKTG prerequisites for the Management minor.
- A minimum of 12 credits, 9 of which must be 300-level courses, in the minor must be taken at Geneseo.
- Minimum competency for all courses presented for the minor in Management is C-.
