Geneseo is a public liberal arts college and is the most selective among the SUNY comprehensive colleges. A distinguished faculty characterized by National and SUNY teaching awards instructs students with outstanding high school records resulting in a 78% college graduation rate. Kiplinger ranked Geneseo No. 14th best value among the nation's public colleges and universities for out of state students and 39th for in-state. In the U.S. News College Rankings, Geneseo ranked 13th on the regional rankings for universities in the northern region and 3rd in the "Top Public Schools Regional Universities North" category in its 2019 Best Colleges Guidebook.
