Class sessions for this final week will be determined by the “DAY & TIME” printed in the Master Schedule of Course Offerings. Late afternoon and evening classes which normally begin at 5:30 pm or later **AND** classes that are held only one day a week that begin at 4:00 or later will hold exams during the evening exam time slot according to the schedule above. **Graduate students should check with their major department regarding exam schedules. All exceptions must be approved in advance by the Interim Associate Provost for Assessment and Curriculum.**

Day classes held in time modules which are different from the “standard” ones above should use the exam time which contains the beginning time of the initial weekly meeting of the class. Since the Final Class Examination Schedule is determined by regular class meeting times, students should—insofar as possible—avoid enrolling in class sections, including late afternoon and evening classes, which meet at times which would cause them to have three or four examinations on the same day.
