

Proposal to teach a Women's Studies and Gender Studies Course

Women's and Gender Studies offers WGST 100: Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies every semester, WGST 230 Intro to Queer Studies in fall of even years, WGST 310: Race, Class and Gender every fall, WGST 320: Gender and Sexualities every spring, and at least one "Topics" class as WGST 201-205 per year. Most of these are required for WGST majors, minors, and concentrators. Each course is 3 credits.
