15-1718 BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE SA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE approve the attached changes to the AAC Bylaws.

*First of Two Readings*

Corey says that the bylaws will be changed to remove individual responsibilities for a presentation and add it under all positions and change it to an "all responsibility." On page 5, impeachment policy has been amended to allow a defense speech on behalf of individuals being impeached. On page 8, Peer Advisement program through Academic Affairs Committee has been amended to be required to be held prior to the first day of registration. Clubs are responsible for submitting a form 3 days before the event. On page 16, a 10% financial penalty has been removed in light of existing policy of two-week Bad Financial Standing being sufficient to penalize clubs for missing meetings. Barak asks if the Peer Advisement section's requirement of 3 days to turn in form is enough time, Corey responds that 3 days is an appropriate amount of time for scheduling changes.
