DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: HISTORY

1. Minimum competence (grade of C- or better) required in all courses taken for the major.
2. The history electives must be chosen on the following basis:
 - A maximum of nine hours at the 100-level
 - A minimum of three courses at the 300-level (9 hours)
 - A minimum of two courses in European history must be at the 200 or 300 level (from HIST 206, 207, 209, 211, 212, 213, 214, 230, 232, 240, 242, 322, 332, 333, 337, 339, 340, 342, 344, 349, 352)
 - A minimum of two courses in United States History must be at the 200 or 300 level (from HIST 204, 250, 256, 258, 260, 261, 262, 263, 264, 266, 267, 352, 353, 355, 356, 357, 360, 361, 363, 366, 367, 368, 369)
 - A minimum of two courses in LACAANA (Latin America, Caribbean, Asia, Africa and Native American) history must be at the 200 or 300 level (from HSIT 232, 242, 261, 270, 271, 280, 281, 282, 291, 292, 355, 362, 372, 380, 381, 382)
3. History majors seeking education certification must consult with advisors and School of Education.
4. At least 69 credit hours must be completed outside History.
5. Majors must fulfill the department writing requirement – see College Bulletin.
