

Students with AP or Transfer Credits:

How to Demonstrate Minimum Competence in Basic Requirements.

Basic Requirements are Psyc 100, Psyc 250, Psyc 251, Psyc 225, and Psyc233.

- Students who take all five basic courses at Geneseo:
 - Minimum C- in each
 - Minimum C average (GPA=2.0)
- Students who transfer or get AP credit for one basic course:
 - GPA is based on the other four basic courses.
 - Minimum C- in each
 - Minimum C average (GPA=2.0)
- Students who transfer or get AP credit for two basic courses:
 - Complete one of the other 200-level requirements (Development or Applied areas).
 - Contact the advisement coordinator to identify the specific course (Dr. Ballard: ballard@geneseo.edu)
 - GPA is based on those 4 courses.
 - Minimum C- in each
 - Minimum C average (GPA=2.0)
- Students who transfer or get AP credit for more than two basic courses
 - Must directly contact department chair.

PLEASE NOTE:

- A grade of C- in all basic requirements will not achieve the required overall GPA of “C”.
- Courses with a grade of C- cannot be repeated (college policy).
- Students with AP / Transfer credit for a non-Psyc statistics class must take an additional Psychology elective for the major.
