Comments on the 2018-19 Annual Report of the Office of Sponsored Research

Traditional Funding Activities: In 2018-19 we reached \$1,500,474 for total awards, which was the result of 26 awards to 27 faculty and staff PIs and Co-PIs in 11 departments. This total is, of course, lower than last year's near record of \$3.57 Million, but is perhaps not surprising given our current level of sponsored programs. During the 2018-19 year 41 faculty and staff members submitted 41 proposals totaling \$4,922,318 in requests. Total grant expenditures for our 47 active projects reached an all time high of \$2,055,005; \$1,646,046 through the Research Foundation for SUNY and \$408,959 through State accounts. These are records for both Research Foundation and State grant account expenditures and this combined number reflects the highest annual grant expenditures in our history.

In the State of New York-funded programs, Milne Library received continuing support from the New York State Education Department. In SUNY-funded programs, faculty and staff from Languages and Literatures, the Dean of Academic Planning and Advising, Biology, the Center for Integrative Learning, the Office of Diversity and Equity, and the Provost's Office, continued work on SUNY Expanded Investment and Performance Fund awards. We also received a new SUNY Performance Improved Fund award for applied learning. A faculty member in Art History had an active SUNY Innovative Instruction Technology Grants (IITG) tier II award and faculty members in Political Science and International Relations and Biology shared held an active IITG tier I award. In addition, one of our English faculty members received notice of a new IITG tier III award for digital scholarly editing and has also received a SUNY Conversations in the Disciplines award for a conference focused on digital projects. The School of Education received a SUNY TeachNY Implementation Fund award for 2018-19 and Health and Counseling held ongoing campus grant support from NY State OASAS.

Our Ronald E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement Program award to the Access Opportunity Programs continued this year, as did the Office of Diversity and Equity's U.S. Department of Justice's Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) award.

In addition to PIF funding, the Biology Department had ongoing research support from the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases and the Livingston County Planning Department, and also had active conference support from NIH and NSF. The Department of Chemistry also received a Jean Dreyfus Lectureship for Undergraduate Students, which supported both a lectureship and undergraduate research stipends.

The School of Education was again very active in 2018-19. Five awards, including those from the United Way, the Wilson Foundation, and the Rochester Area Community Foundation's (RACF) Feinblom Supporting Foundation, supported the Soaring Stars program. We also received notice of new awards from the RACF and the United Way of Greater Rochester (through the Greater Rochester Summer Learning Program) for support of Soaring Stars for summer 2019. The Rochester Young Scholars Academy at Geneseo received support from the Greater Rochester Summer Learning Association and the Rochester City School District (RCSD) and notice of a new United Way of Greater Rochester award for support of the 2019 program as well. A continuing award from RCSD supports our partnership with the Dr. Charles T. Lunford School 19 on its School Improvement Grant.

Faculty members in the Geography Department had continuing NSF research support and faculty from the English Department received a Modern Language Association award for curriculum development. Another faculty member had NSF I-Corps team support for a tech transfer project. The Department of Geological Sciences received notice of two awards: one from NASA and a NASA subaward through SUNY Stony Brook. The Department also had ongoing research funding from the Jet Propulsion Lab and NASA and ongoing NSF support for the GEOS S-STEM scholarship program. A faculty member in Mathematics held ongoing NSF research funding.

The Department of Music received a Council on Library and Information Resources grant for digitization of New York State square dance recordings and videos from the Kimball music collection. The Galleries held NEH support for a traveling exhibition.

The Department of Physics and Astronomy had continuing support for its NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program and received an NSF supplement for its Research Experiences for Undergraduates (REU) site, Supporting Undergraduate Research at Geneseo (SURGE). Faculty

members also secured new awards from the U.S. Department of Energy through the Laboratory for Laser Energetics at the University of Rochester—the first year of a new five year cycle—and NASA through Cornell University's Space Grant.

The Psychology Department received a new National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism (NIAAA) subaward from the University at Buffalo and had continuing support from two Academic Research Enhancements Awards from the National Institute on Drug Abuse and the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke.

During 2018-19 we continued our relationship with McAllister & Quinn (M&Q) whose staff members worked with us on proposals submitted to the NEH Humanities Connections program, the NSF Research Experiences for Undergraduates and Major Research Instrumentation programs, and to the National Institutes of Health for an Academic Research Enhancement Award. The majority of our effort with McAllister & Quinn this year centered around an NSF ADVANCE (Organizational Change for Gender Equity in STEM Academic Professions) proposal which was submitted on behalf of the 29 members of the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges (COPLAC) in May. The ADVANCE proposal involves a collaboration between Geneseo, three other COPLAC institutions (Georgia College & State University, the University of Virginia's College at Wise, the University of North Carolina at Asheville), and the University of Washington.

Internal Funding: In collaboration with the Geneseo Foundation, the Research Foundation for SUNY, and the Offices of Accounting and Grants Management, the Research Council reviewed applications from faculty members and students that resulted in 431 individual awards with a total value of \$331,675. Total internal funding for our formal grant and fellowship programs, combined with other planned expenditures in support of research and scholarly activities, amounted to \$360,113—a record.

GREAT Day: Geneseo's thirteenth annual GREAT Day showcased a total of 561 presentations (which included 282 posters), performances, and exhibits. This reflected the scholarly and creative work of 1,001 students who were sponsored by 166 faculty and staff members. Dr. Stephanie Singer, a data strategist who is a consultant for Verified Voting and former Chair of the Philadelphia County Board of Elections, presented the eleventh annual keynote address supported by the Jack '76 and Carol '76 Kramer Endowed Lectureship, "Democracy: Your Path to Power," to an audience of more than 300.

Other Initiatives: This year we hosted two events sponsored by outside organizations: 1) The COPLAC NE Regional Undergraduate Research, Scholarly and Creative Activity Conference which was held on October 19-20, 2018, and had 71 attendees and 52 presentations; and 2) The Rochester Academy of Science's Annual Fall Scientific Paper Session, which was held on November 10, 2018, and had 393 attendees and 158 presentations.

EXTERNAL GRANT EXPENDITURES PROFILED BY TYPE OF ACTIVITY 2004-05 to 2018-19








EXTERNAL GRANT EXPENDITURES BY DEPARTMENT

RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS 2018-19

The Research Council offers a wide range of programs to support research development and scholarly and creative activity.

Programs for Faculty Members

- **Presidential Summer Fellowships** provide untenured faculty with an opportunity to participate in scholarly activities and establish an ongoing research program. Up to six \$3,500 stipends are awarded annually from funds provided by the College.
- **Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Fellowship** support the research and creative projects of faculty who have been awarded tenure. These fellowships are intended to enable completion of a significant project or to embark in a new direction. The \$4,000 Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships are funded by the Geneseo Foundation, and the \$5,000 Roemer award is supported by an endowment gift to the Geneseo Foundation from the late Dr. Spencer Roemer.
- **Proposal Writing Support Awards** provide full-time faculty members with time and other forms of support to write proposals requesting at least \$15,000 in funding for submission to external funding agencies. Faculty members may request support for the writing of either: 1) new proposals, or 2) significant revisions of previously submitted proposals. Support will be considered for major proposals in all academic fields and for a variety of initiatives (e.g. fellowships, research grants, or educational grants). The maximum individual award is \$3,750, one course reassignment, or \$2,500 for summer salary. Collaborative submissions are also supported. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Research Development Awards** provide support for a wide variety of needs associated with developing research and scholarly projects. Maximum award is \$1,000 or one course reassignment. Funded by the College.
- **Indirect Cost Return Awards** return part of the indirect costs to the project director for research expenses not covered by budgeted costs. Funded by the College.
- **Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty initiatives in research and to fund pilot studies, completion of manuscripts, data analyses, bibliographic or archival searches, and creative work. Travel to archives, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000, but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the cost of involving a student in the proposed project. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Faculty Travel Grants** are made to participants in professional meetings. Maximum annual awards are \$800 for travel within the U.S. (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and \$1,000 for travel to Hawaii or outside the U.S. and Canada. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Page Charge** allocations cover the costs of faculty publications in journals with mandatory page charges. Funded by the College.
- The **Hurrell/McNaron Award for Scholarly Presentation** provides a \$1,000 award to an untenured faculty member in support of an outstanding paper delivered at a major conference in the discipline. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an anonymous donor.

Programs for Students

- **Undergraduate Travel, Research, and Creativity (TRAC) Grants** support student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester or \$1,800 per group per semester. Funded by the Student Association and the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Graduate Student Research and Travel Grants** support graduate student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester. Funded by the College.
- **The Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes Research Award** supports undergraduate student research or field study. Preference is given to scholarly research combining a natural science and a social science such as biology/sociology or geology/ anthropology. The awardee is chosen from among successful Geneseo Foundation Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship and Geneseo Foundation Research Assistantship applicants. The maximum award is \$600. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes.
- **Dean Johnston and Geneseo Foundation Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with research assistants for their scholarly projects. Undergraduate students receive a stipend of \$1,000. Funded through an endowment established by CPAC, Inc.
- **Undergraduate Summer Fellowships** provide a \$3,000 (full-time) or \$1,000 (part-time) stipend for students to undertake a research or creative project under the direction of a faculty member. Students must devote to their project either two consecutive summer months of effort for full-time awards or approximately 3 weeks (which may be spread across the summer) for part-time awards. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Jason and Diana Kyrwood '95 Student/Faculty Research Endowed Fellowship in Honor of Ellen Kintz** provides \$2,500 plus an additional \$500 (\$3,000 total) for a stipend for an undergraduate student to work with a faculty member in the social sciences on an existing research project. Recipients must devote two consecutive summer months to the project. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Jason and Diana Kyrwood in honor of emerita faculty member Ellen Kintz.
- **Sorrell Chesin '58 Research Award** provides financial support to recognize students who have successfully undertaken a research experience in the physical and natural sciences and related disciplines under the direction or mentorship of a faculty member in the field of study and to promote this research experience. Funded by an endowment established by Sorrell Chesin '58.



