Comments on the 2021-22 Annual Report of the Office of Sponsored Research

Traditional Funding Activities: In 2021-22 we reached \$2,699,112 for total awards, which was the result of 13 awards to 19 faculty PIs and co-PIs in 7 academic departments and 2 Offices and Centers. This is the 4th highest dollar amount of annual awards in the last 22 years. During the 2021-22 year, 30 faculty and staff members submitted 26 proposals totaling \$7,334,285 in requests. Total grant expenditures for our 38 active projects reached \$2,523,060; \$140,475 on two State account awards and \$2,382,585 for 36 awards administered through the Research Foundation for SUNY. This is the first time our Research Foundation for SUNY expenditures have exceeded \$2 million—an all-time record for the College.

In the State of New York-funded programs, Milne Library received continuing support from the New York State Education Department; and Health and Counseling held ongoing campus grant support from NY State OASAS. In SUNY programs, the Provost's Office had ongoing support for the Computational Analytics Cluster from the SUNY Empire Innovation Fund.

Our TRIO Ronald E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement Program and Student Support Services Program awards to Access Opportunity Programs continued this year and a renewal proposal for the McNair program was submitted as well. A renewal proposal was also submitted to the U.S. Department of Justice's Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) from the Title IX Office.

The Center for Integrative Learning had ongoing support from the Northern Border Regional Commission Grant (prime funding source USDA) and Bringing Theory to Practice. The Center for Community submitted to and received funding from Humanities New York for a reading and discussion group. The University Police were awarded a three-year Body-worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies award from the DOJ's Bureau of Justice Assistance.

The Biology Department received a new award from the National Marine Sanctuary Foundation/NOAA and had ongoing support from the Livingston County Planning Department, the National Institute for Allergy and Infectious Diseases, and the National Science Foundation's Research Coordination Networks in Undergraduate Biology Education (RCN-UBE) Program and the Supporting Academically Talented STEM Undergraduates with Scholarships (S-STEM) Program. Faculty in Chemistry, Geological Sciences, and Biology were awarded a National Science Foundation Major Research Instrumentation award for a confocal Raman microscope system. Chemistry faculty also had continuing support from the Camille and Henry Dreyfus Foundation and from two NSF awards. The first, which has a co-PI in the Department of Political Science and International Relations, is an ADVANCE: Organizational Change for Gender Equity in STEM Academic Professions award and the second is an Improving Undergraduate Science Education (IUSE) award.

The School of Education received awards from the United Way of Greater Rochester and the Finger Lakes and the Rochester Area Community Foundation's (RACF) Feinbloom Supporting Foundation and had continuing support from the Greater Rochester Summer Learning Association, the United Way of Livingston County, the NEA Foundation, and the Rochester City School District in support of our partnership with the Dr. Charles T. Lunsford School 19 on its School Improvement Grant.

Faculty members in the Geography Department had continuing NSF research support. Faculty in Geological Sciences and Education received a new 5-year NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program award. Two Geological Sciences faculty members received Fulbright awards for the 2022-23 year (one to the Czech Republic and one to Colombia). Geological Sciences had continuing support from NASA directly and a NASA subaward through SUNY Stony Brook. Faculty in the History Department received new awards from the Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation and the National Endowment for the Humanities American Rescue Plan. History faculty also had ongoing support from the National Heritage Trust and the Rochester Area Community Foundation.

Faculty in the Philosophy Department received an award from the Philosophy Learning and Teaching Organization (PLATO) in support of the Geneseo Summer Institute in Justice and Ethics in Modern America.

The Department of Physics and Astronomy had continuing support from: the U.S. Department of Energy through the University of Rochester's Laboratory for Laser Energetics; the NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program; NSF astronomy research in collaboration with the University of Indiana; and NASA through Cornell University's Space Grant.

In addition to the ongoing NSF ADVANCE program support noted above, the Political Science and International Relations Department had ongoing support from two another Jack Miller Center awards to continue the Forum on Constitutionalism and Democracy.

The Psychology Department continued research supported by two Academic Research Enhancement (AREA) awards from the National Institute on Drug Abuse and the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke.

During 2021-22 we continued our relationship with McAllister & Quinn (M&Q), whose staff members worked with us on proposals submitted to: the NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program; the NSF Faculty Early Career Development (CAREER) Program; the NSF Major Research Instrumentation Program, the National Endowment for the Humanities American Rescue Program; the NIH Academic Research Enhancement Award Program, and the Ronald. E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement Program.

Internal Funding: In collaboration with the Geneseo Foundation, the Research Foundation for SUNY, and the Offices of Accounting and Grants Management, the Research Council reviewed applications from faculty members and students that resulted in 358 individual awards with a total value of \$265,739. Total internal funding for our formal grant and fellowship programs, combined with other planned expenditures in support of research and scholarly activities, amounted to \$310,821.

GREAT Day: On April 21, 2022, after two years of virtual events, we were once again able to hold the 16th annual GREAT Day in person. GREAT Day was administered by the Director of the Center for Integrative Learning (CIL) Lytton Smith, in collaboration with the Director of Sponsored Research Anne Baldwin. The Music Festival was co-coordinated by Monica Hershberger, Assistant Professor of Music, and Andrea Klein, Director of Campus Events & Scheduling, who also provided tremendous support for GREAT Day. We utilized a new conference platform, Oxford Abstracts, this year, which was used for abstract submissions, event scheduling, and the online program for attendees. We also provided CAS gift cards to participants in lieu of the traditional buffet lunch. GREAT Day 2022 was an excellent success with 553 students presenting under the mentorship of 119 faculty and staff members. Details on GREAT Day can be found on pages 24 and 25.

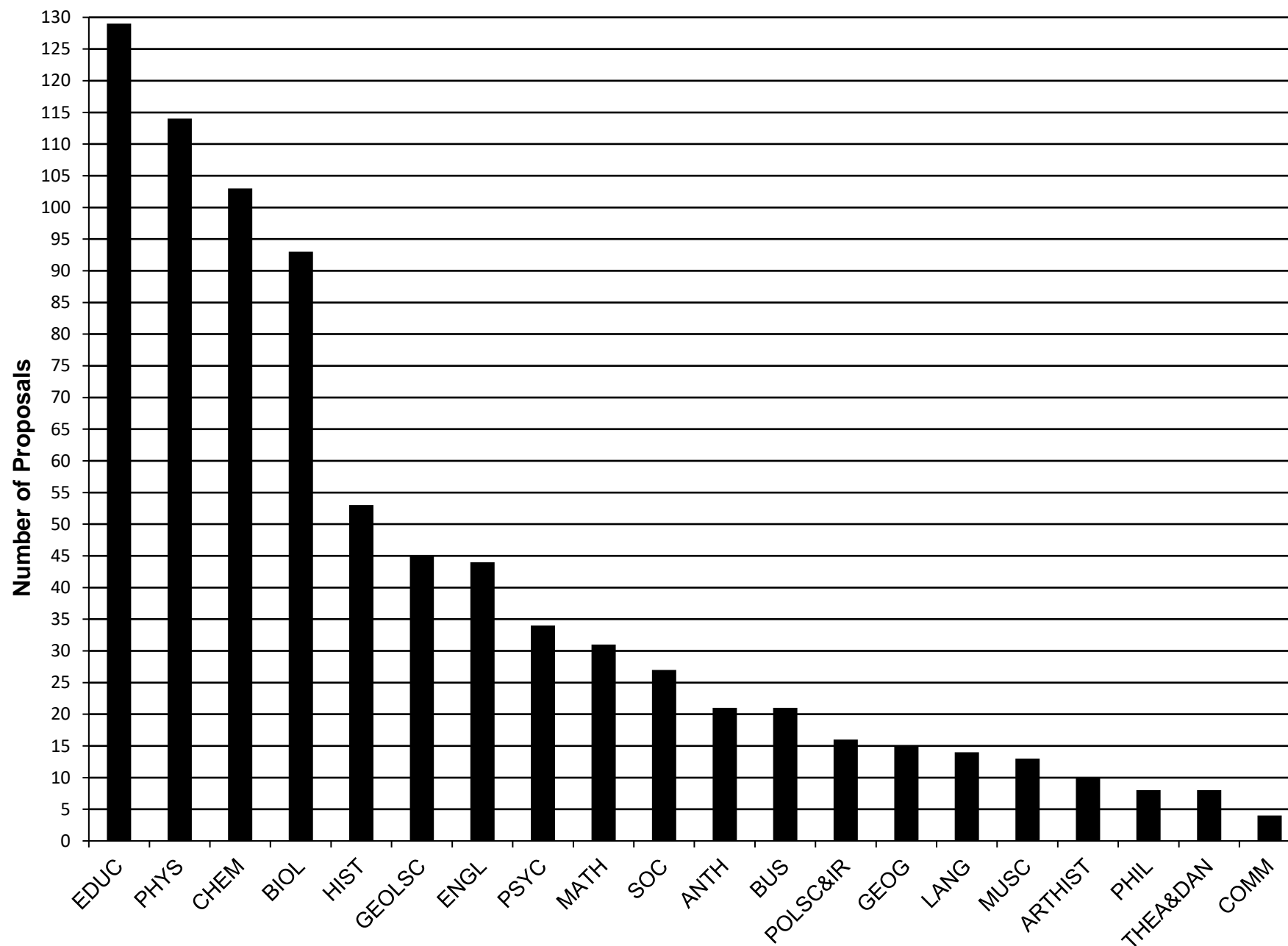

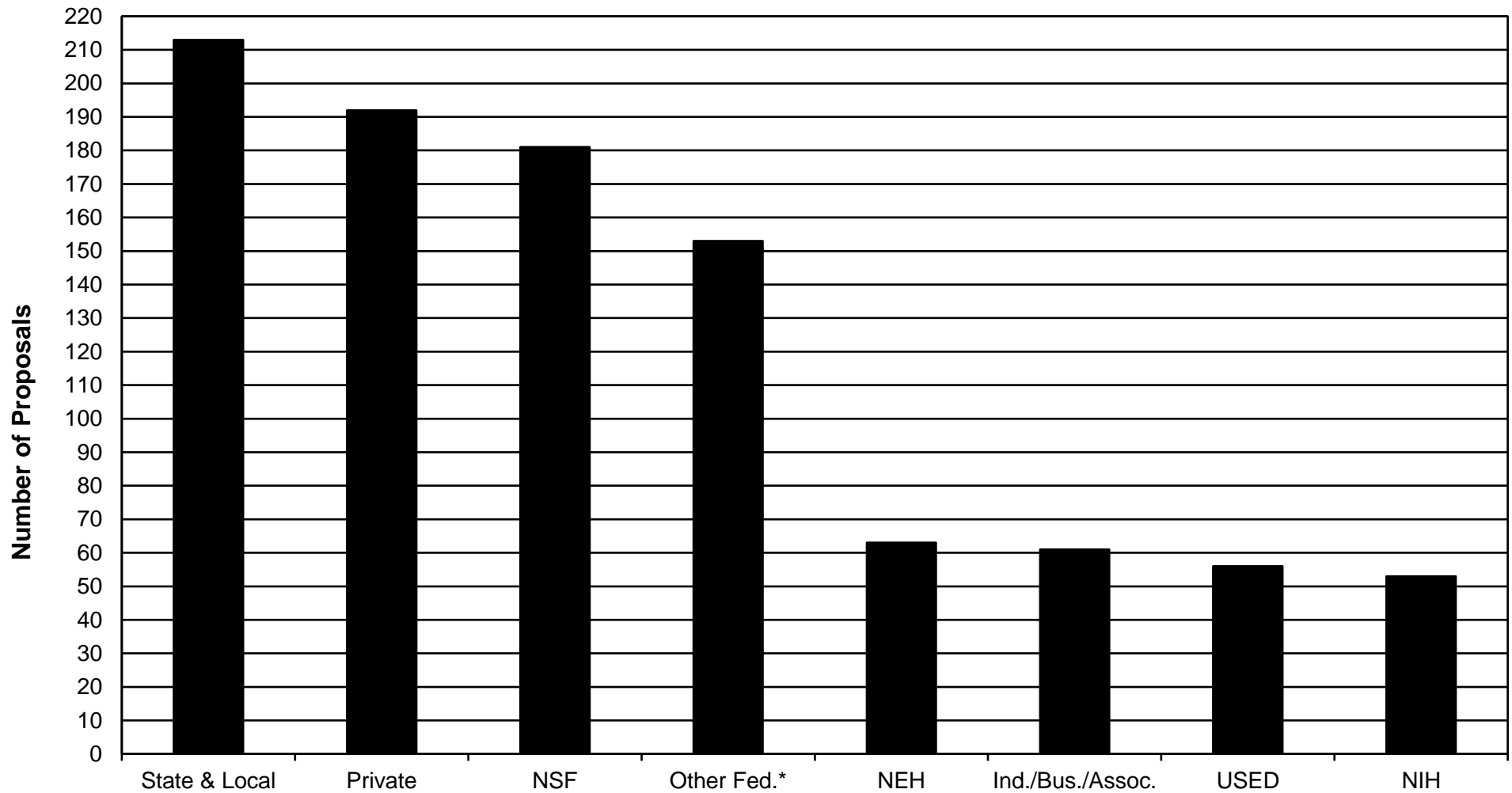

RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS 2021-22

The Research Council offers a wide range of programs to support research development and scholarly and creative activity.

Programs for Faculty Members

- **Presidential Summer Fellowships** provide untenured faculty with an opportunity to participate in scholarly activities and establish an ongoing research program. Up to six \$3,500 stipends are awarded annually from funds provided by the College.
- **Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Fellowship** support the research and creative projects of faculty who have been awarded tenure. These fellowships are intended to enable completion of a significant project or to embark in a new direction. The \$4,000 Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships are funded by the Geneseo Foundation, and the \$5,000 Roemer award is supported by an endowment gift to the Geneseo Foundation from the late Dr. Spencer Roemer.
- **Proposal Writing Support Awards** provide full-time faculty members with time and other forms of support to write proposals requesting at least \$15,000 in funding for submission to external funding agencies. Faculty members may request support for the writing of either: 1) new proposals, or 2) significant revisions of previously submitted proposals. Support will be considered for major proposals in all academic fields and for a variety of initiatives (e.g. fellowships, research grants, or educational grants). The maximum individual award is \$3,750, one course reassignment, or \$2,500 for summer salary. Collaborative submissions are also supported. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Research Development Awards** provide support for a wide variety of needs associated with developing research and scholarly projects. Maximum award is \$1,000 or one course reassignment. Funded by the College.
- **Indirect Cost Return Awards** return part of the indirect costs to the project director for research expenses not covered by budgeted costs. Funded by the College.
- **Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty initiatives in research and to fund pilot studies, completion of manuscripts, data analyses, bibliographic or archival searches, and creative work. Travel to archives, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000, but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the cost of involving a student in the proposed project. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Faculty Travel Grants** are made to participants in professional meetings. Maximum annual awards are \$800 for travel within the U.S. (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and \$1,000 for travel to Hawaii or outside the U.S. and Canada. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Pre-Tenure Faculty Research Support Awards** were established to assist tenure-track faculty whose research and scholarly work has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Tenure-track faculty who have not yet submitted their tenure package are eligible for a base amount of \$250, but may request an additional \$250 if needed. Total award amounts are generally limited to \$500, but if program funds remain after two deadlines, then an additional deadline is announced. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Page Charge** allocations cover the costs of faculty publications in journals with mandatory page charges. Funded by the College.

Programs for Students

- **Undergraduate Travel, Research, and Creativity (TRAC) Grants** support student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester or \$1,800 per group per semester. Funded by the Student Association and the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Graduate Student Research and Travel Grants** support graduate student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester. Funded by the College.
- **The Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes Research Award** supports undergraduate student research or field study. Preference is given to scholarly research combining a natural science and a social science such as biology/sociology or geology/ anthropology. The awardee is chosen from among successful Geneseo Foundation Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship and Geneseo Foundation Research Assistantship applicants. The maximum award is \$600. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes.
- **Dean Johnston and Geneseo Foundation Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with research assistants for their scholarly projects. Undergraduate students receive a stipend of \$1,000. Funded through an endowment established by CPAC, Inc.
- **Undergraduate Summer Fellowships** provide a \$3,000 (full-time) or \$1,000 (part-time) stipend for students to undertake a research or creative project under the direction of a faculty member. Students must devote to their project either two consecutive summer months of effort for full-time awards or approximately 3 weeks (which may be spread across the summer) for part-time awards. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Jason and Diana Kyrwood '95 Student/Faculty Research Endowed Fellowship in Honor of Ellen Kintz** provides \$2,500 plus an additional \$500 (\$3,000 total) for a stipend for an undergraduate student to work with a faculty member in the social sciences on an existing research project. Recipients must devote two consecutive summer months to the project. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Jason and Diana Kyrwood in honor of emerita faculty member Ellen Kintz.
- **Sorrell Chesin '58 Research Award** provides financial support to recognize students who have successfully undertaken a research experience in the physical and natural sciences and related disciplines under the direction or mentorship of a faculty member in the field of study and to promote this research experience. Funded by an endowment established by Sorrell Chesin '58.

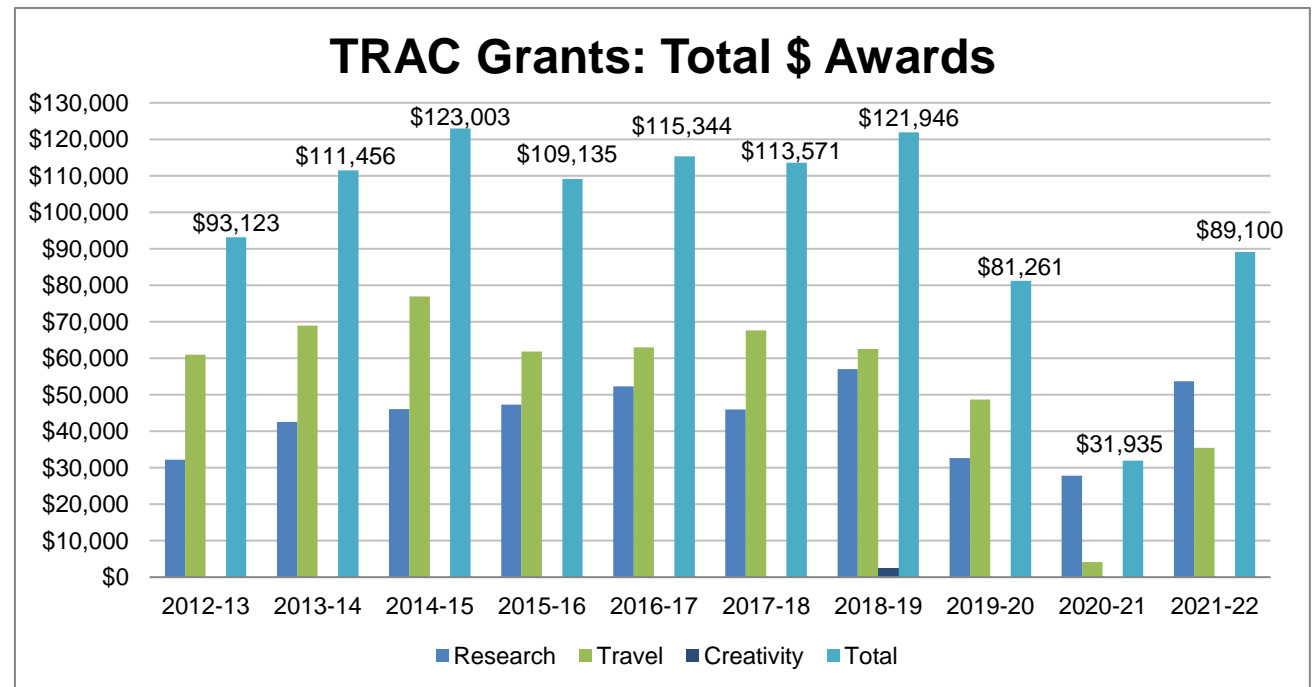
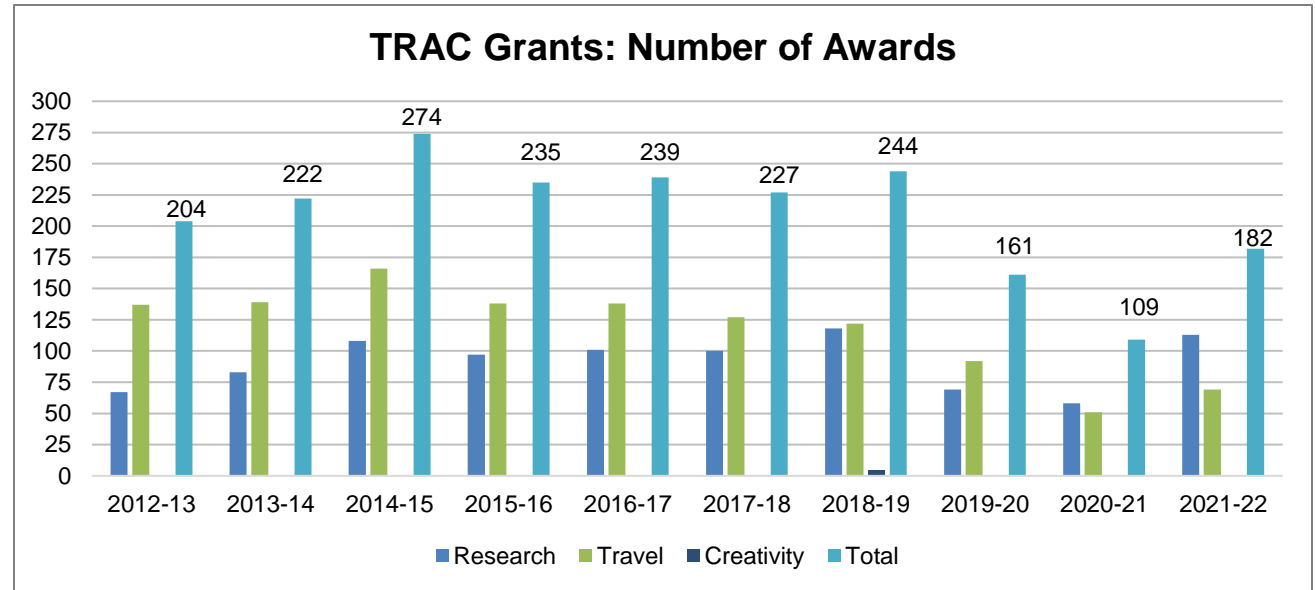

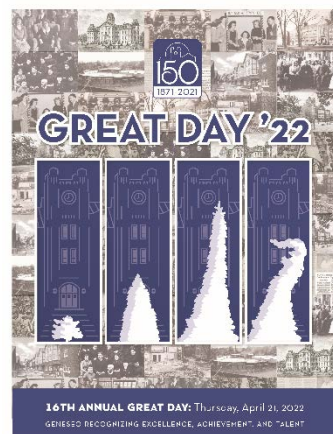
