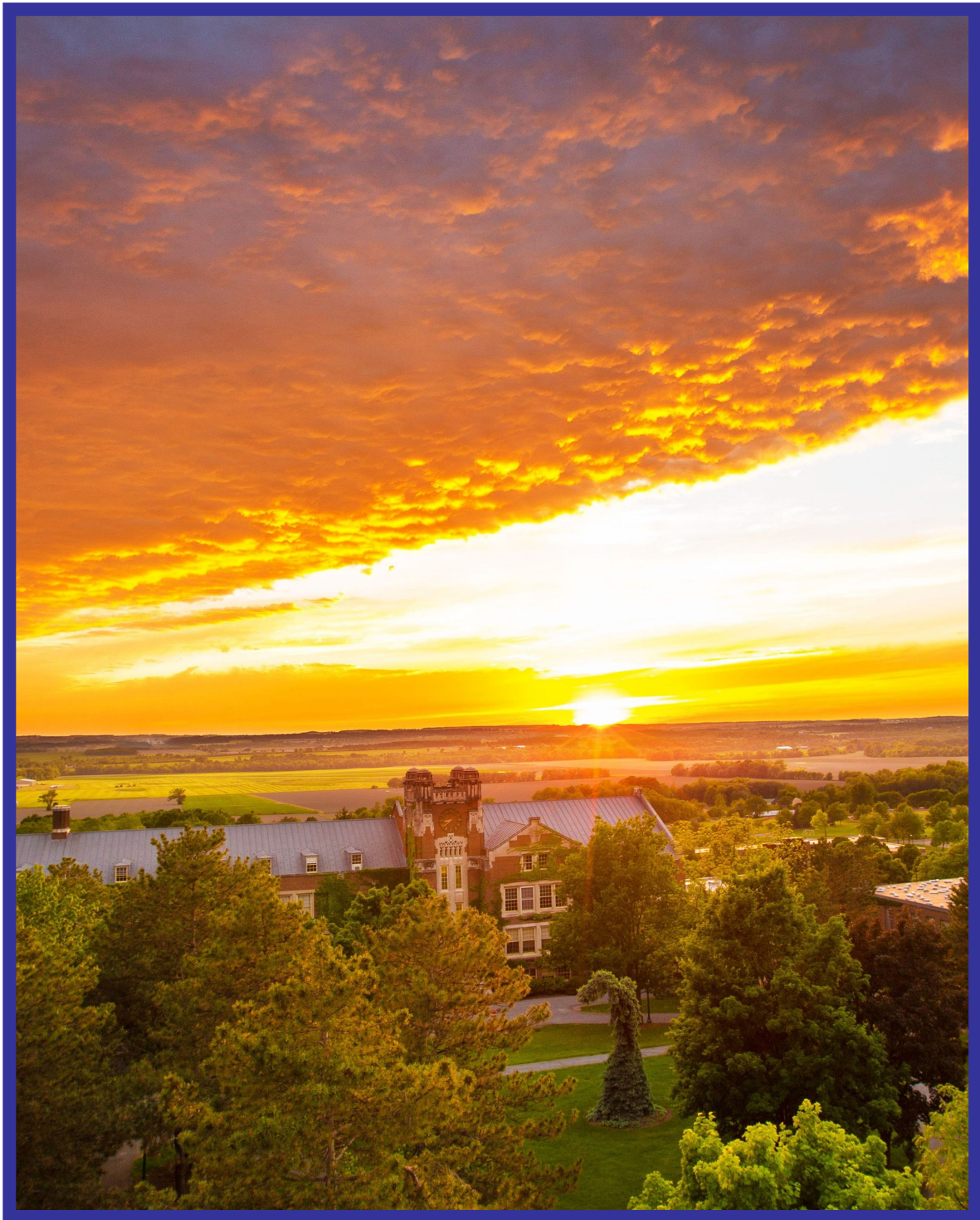

Comments on the Annual Report of the Office of Sponsored Research

Traditional Funding Activities: The number of external proposal submissions reached an all-time high in 2013-14. Forty-eight faculty and staff members representing 20 different departments and offices generated a total of 65 proposal submissions totaling \$15,118,032 in requests. The value of the 22 awards received during the year totaled \$1,006,593. Total grant expenditures for our 35 active projects was \$819,559—\$709,767 through the Research Foundation for SUNY and \$109,787 through State accounts. Support from SUNY central and the Research Foundation for SUNY played a significant part in 2013-14 activities. Faculty and staff from Milne Library, Residence Life and the Departments of English and Languages and Literatures had active SUNY Innovative Instruction Technology Grant (IITG) awards and two new IITG awards were made to Mathematics and Geological Sciences for the coming year. Faculty members in Chemistry and Sociology had active UWI-SUNY Collaboration Seed Fund awards for collaboration visits to develop joint research or instructional projects. The Department of Languages and Literatures also had support from the SUNY Office of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion for an undergraduate forum, “First World Diaspora,” which was held during the spring of 2014. An award to the Physics Department from the SUNY 4E Network of Excellence is supporting a Biofuels Research and Education Collaboration among SUNY institutions.

A new award to the Biology Department from the Livingston County Planning Department will support Conesus Lake invasive species monitoring, and continued funding through a National Institutes of Health (NIH) award also supported research during the year. The Chemistry Department's U.S. Department of Energy award provided continuing support for the Molecular Structure Lab. A National Endowment for the Humanities award through the University of Vermont to the English Department supported a Summer Seminar on Dante's *Commedia* in Italy. A faculty member in Geological Sciences received a Fulbright for research and teaching in Chile for the fall semester of 2014 and research in the department was supported by four on-going National Science Foundation (NSF) grants. A faculty member in the History Department received two fellowship awards from the National Endowment for the Humanities and the National Humanities Center which will provide two years of support. A faculty member in the Mathematics Department received awards from the Center for Undergraduate Research in Mathematics and the Educational Advancement Foundation, the latter of which will support an Upstate New York Inquiry-Based Learning Network. Faculty members in the Department of Physics and Astronomy continued research and educational programs with on-going funding from the Physics Teacher Education Coalition, the U.S. Department of Energy (through the Laboratory for Laser Energetics, University of Rochester), and NASA (through Cornell University). An award from the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) supported a Physics undergraduate for a Summer Undergraduate Research Fellowship (SURF) at NIST. The Psychology Department also had on-going support from NIH, and an AAC&U Bringing Theory to Practice award to Psychology will support a project on well-being of students in living learning communities. A new NCAA Division III Ethnic Minority and Women's Internship grant award to the Athletics Department will provide two years of support for an intern.

The School of Education continued to secure funding for summer programs this year. Working with the Greater Rochester Summer Learning Association, and thanks to new funds from the Max and Marian Farash Charitable Foundation and continued funding from the Rochester City School District, the Rochester Young Scholars Academy was able to expand this year's "Waterworld" summer camp program to 90 students. In addition, the combination of new support from the Feinbloom Supporting Foundation, Fulbright Canada, and the Livingston County United Way, and continuing support from a three-year commitment from the Marie C. and Joseph C. Wilson Foundation and the Genesee Valley Educational Partnership allowed the Soaring Stars summer program for rural K-6 students to expand to include a third cohort of students. The School of Education has also entered into a new partnership with James Munroe High School, supported by a School Improvement Grant, which will provide programs for both teachers and students.

In the spring of 2014 we entered into an agreement with the firm McAllister & Quinn to provide proposal development, writing, and review support for four large institutional proposals per year. During the 2013-14 year McAllister & Quinn staff worked with our faculty and staff on a \$1.2M NSF proposal for pre-service physics teacher scholarships and a \$1.8M proposal to the Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education for a STEM program for our Access Opportunity Programs students.

Internal Funding: In collaboration with the Genesee Foundation, the Research Foundation for SUNY, and the Offices of Accounting and Grants Management, the Research Council reviewed applications from faculty members and students that resulted in 382 individual awards totaling \$301,659. Total internal funding for our formal grant and fellowship programs, combined with other planned expenditures in support of research and scholarly activities, amounted to more than \$319,000.

GREAT Day: Genesee's eighth annual GREAT Day was a tremendous success with 881 students participating in 452 presentations, performances, and exhibits. Sheri Fink, author of the bestselling *Five Days at Memorial*, presented the sixth annual keynote address supported by the Jack '76 and Carol '76 Kramer Endowed Lectureship. Her address focused on the life and death decisions faced at New Orleans' Memorial Hospital following the devastation of Hurricane Katrina in August of 2005.

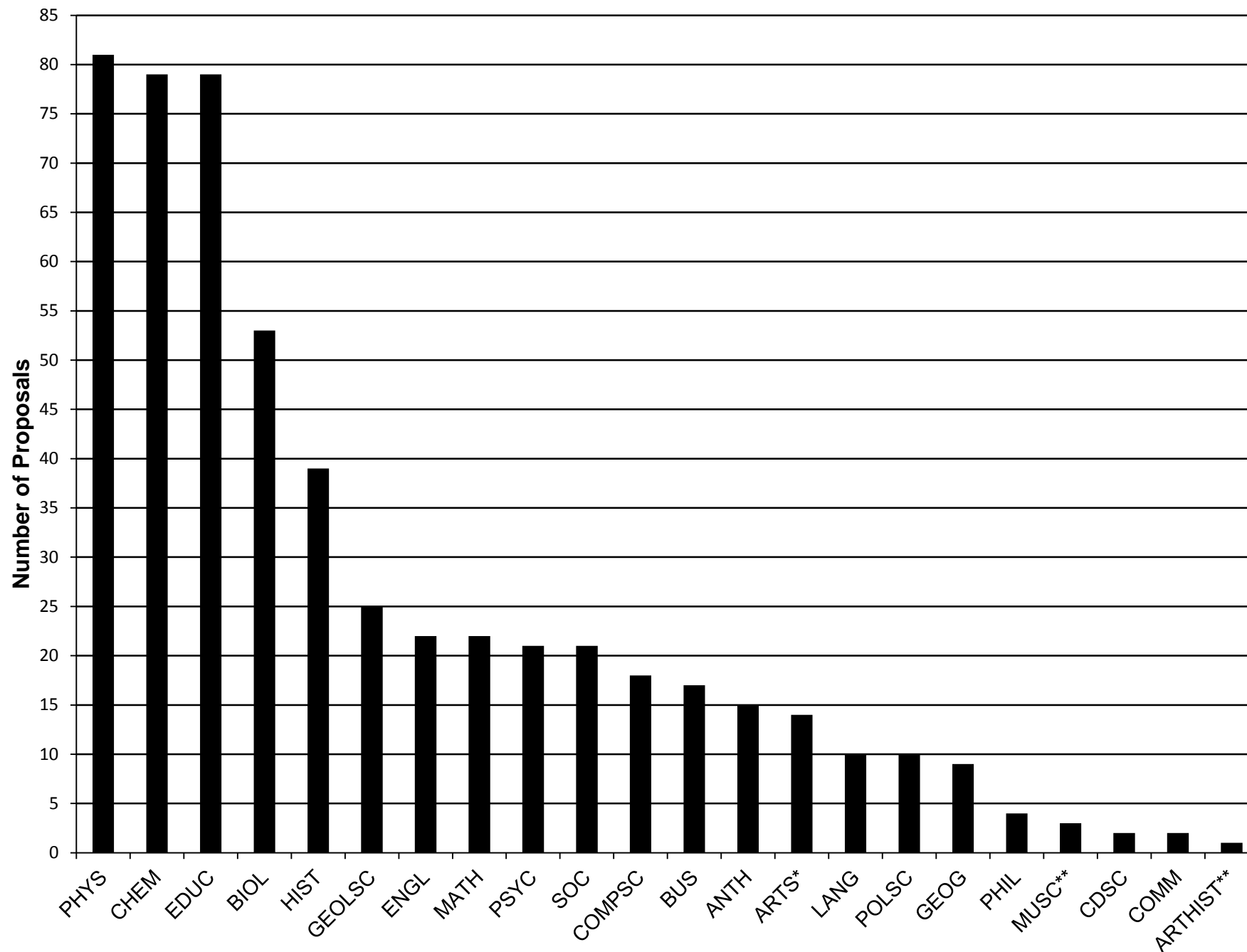

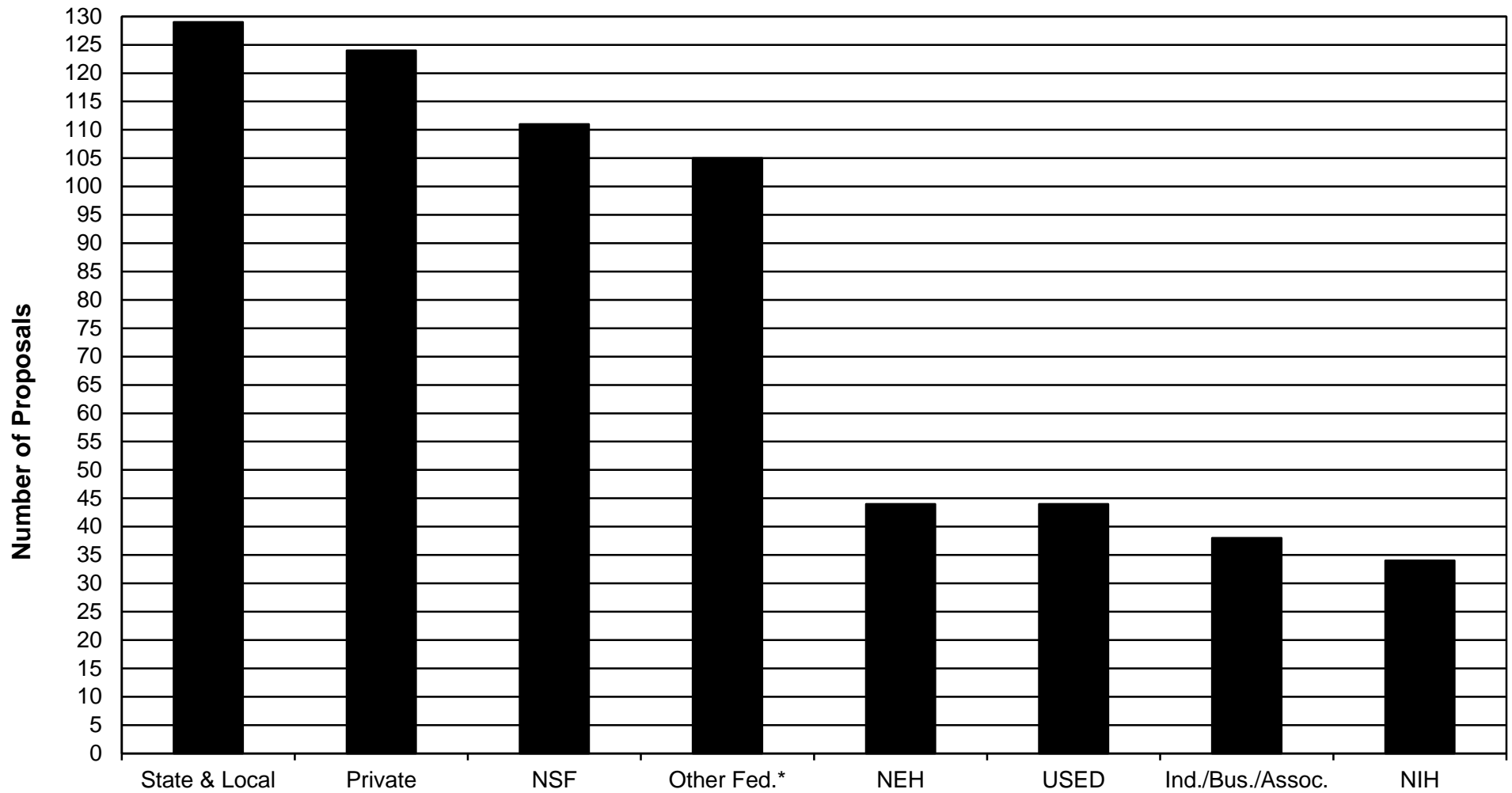

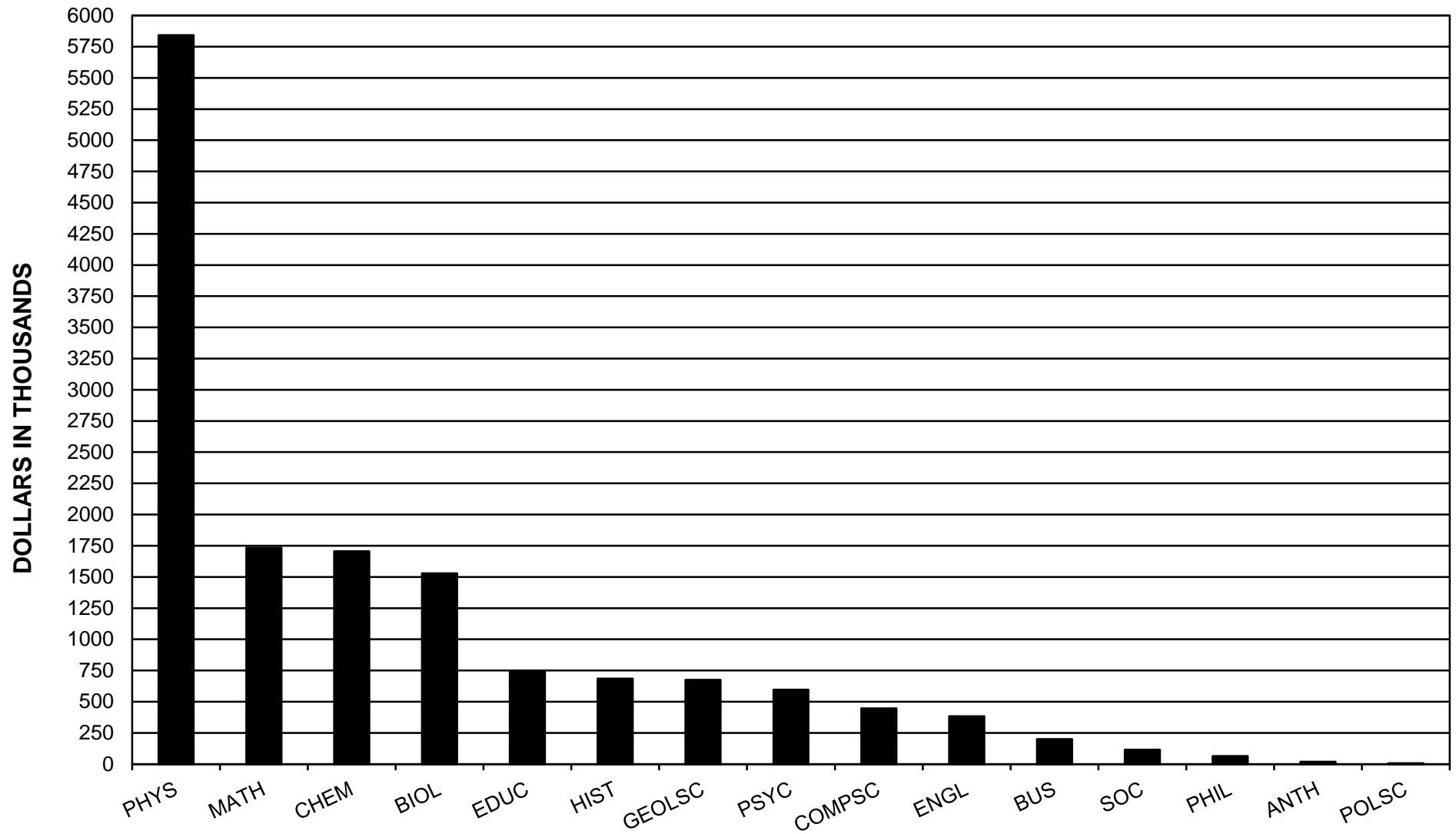

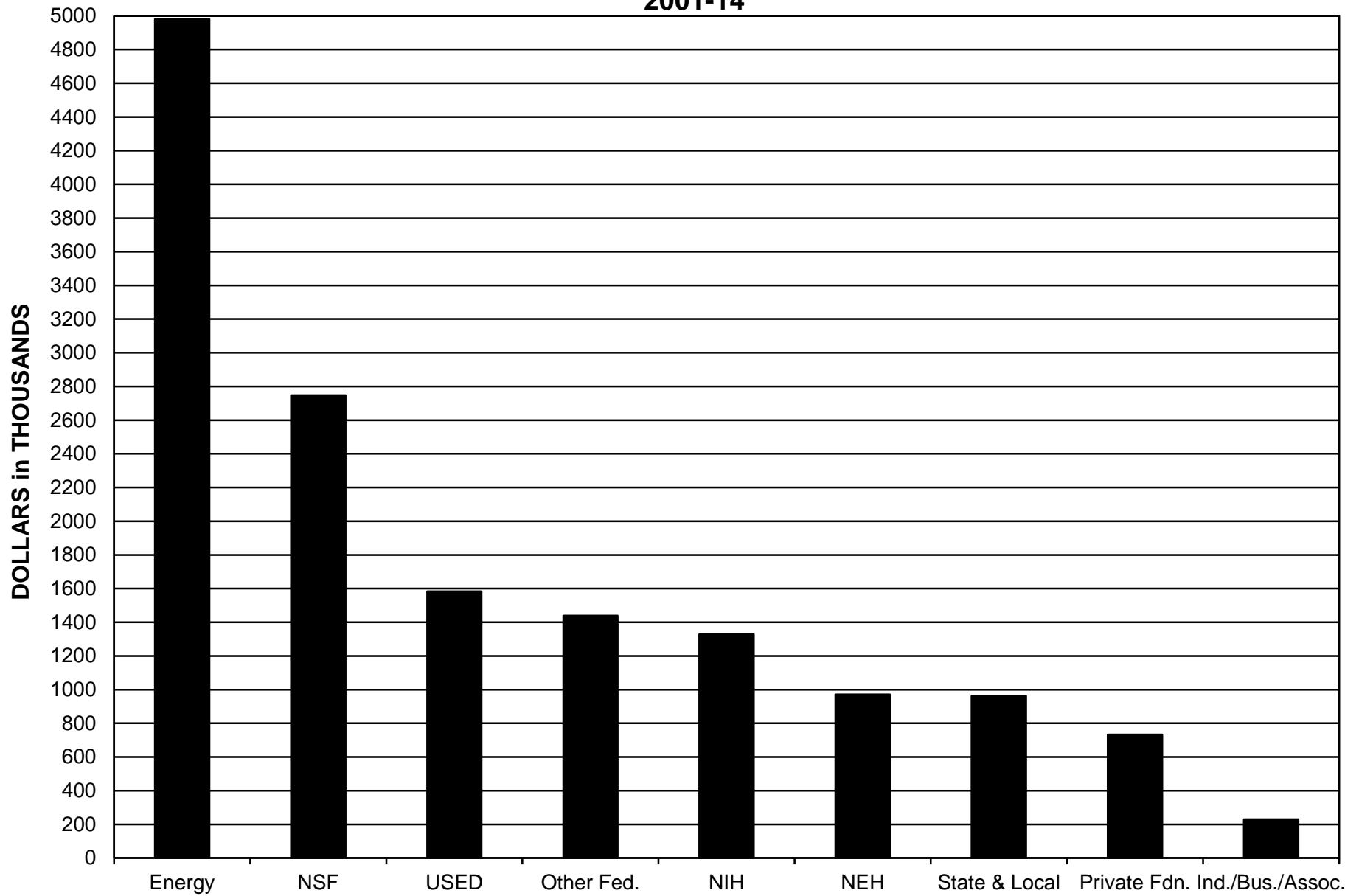

RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS 2013-14

The Research Council offers a wide range of programs to support research development and scholarly and creative activity.

Programs for Faculty Members

- **Presidential Summer Fellowships** provide untenured faculty with an opportunity to participate in scholarly activities and establish an ongoing research program. Up to six \$3,500 stipends are awarded annually from funds provided by the College.
- **Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Fellowship** support the research and creative projects of faculty who have been awarded tenure. These fellowships are intended to enable completion of a significant project or to embark in a new direction. The \$4,000 Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships are funded by the Geneseo Foundation, and the \$5,000 Roemer award is supported by an endowment gift to the Geneseo Foundation from the late Dr. Spencer Roemer.
- **CIEE International Faculty Development Seminar Award** supports the participation of one member of our faculty in a summer seminar of their choosing as offered annually by the Council on International Educational Exchange. The award provides \$5,000 towards the seminar fee and other related expenses. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Proposal Writing Support Awards** provide full-time faculty members with time and other forms of support to write major proposals for submission to external funding agencies. Faculty members may request support for the writing of either: 1) new proposals, or 2) significant revisions of previously submitted proposals. Support will be considered for major proposals in all academic fields and for a variety of initiatives (e.g. fellowships, research grants, or educational grants). The maximum award is \$3,750, one course release, or \$2,500 for summer salary. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Research Development Awards** provide support for a wide variety of needs associated with developing research and scholarly projects. Maximum award is \$1,000 or one course release. Funding is provided by the College.
- **Indirect Cost Return Awards** return part of the indirect costs to the project director for research expenses not covered by budgeted costs. Funded by the College.
- **Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty initiatives in research and to fund pilot studies, completion of manuscripts, data analyses, bibliographic or archival searches, and creative work. Travel to archives, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000, but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the cost of involving a student in the proposed project. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Faculty Travel Grants** are made to participants in professional meetings. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation. Maximum annual awards are \$800 for travel within the U.S. (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and \$1,000 for travel to Hawaii or outside the U.S. and Canada.

- **Page Charge** allocations cover the costs of faculty publications in journals with mandatory page charges. Funded by the College.
- The **Hurrell/McNaron Award for Scholarly Presentation** provides a \$1,000 award to an untenured faculty member in support of an outstanding paper delivered at a major conference in the discipline. The award is funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an anonymous donor.

Programs for Students

- **Undergraduate Research and Travel Grants** support student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester or \$1,500 per group per semester. Funded by the Student Association and the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Graduate Student Research and Travel Grants** support graduate student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester. Funded by the College.
- **The Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes Research Award** supports undergraduate student research or field study. Preference is given to scholarly research combining a natural science and a social science such as biology/sociology or geology/anthropology. The awardee is chosen from among successful Geneseo Foundation Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship and Geneseo Foundation Research Assistantship applicants. The maximum award is \$600. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes.
- **Dean Johnston and Geneseo Foundation Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with paid research assistants for their scholarly projects. Undergraduate students receive a stipend of \$1,000. The Dean Johnston Assistantships are funded through an endowment established by CPAC, Inc.
- **Undergraduate Summer Fellowships** provide a \$3,000 stipend for students to undertake a research or creative project under the direction of a faculty member. Students must devote two consecutive summer months to their project. Funded by Follett Higher Education Group and the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Research Foundation for SUNY/SUNY Geneseo STEM Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowships** support research experiences for undergraduate students in the science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) fields under the direction of a faculty member. Awards of \$3,500 each will provide each fellow a stipend and up to \$500 for research supplies. Funded by the Research Foundation for SUNY and the Geneseo Foundation.

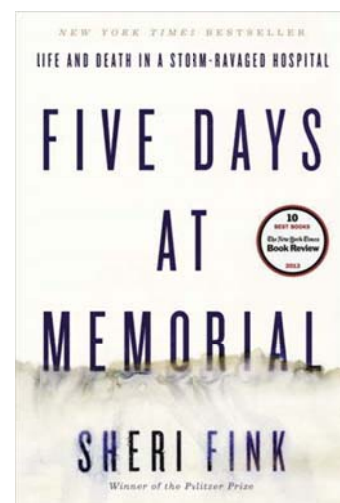

Sheri Fink, Author, “Five Days at Memorial”

New York Times Top 10 Book for 2013

As an activist, Sheri Fink has traveled to every continent except Antarctica. A former relief worker in disaster and conflict zones, she has experienced some of the world's most volatile regions. Ms. Fink has utilized her experiences to become an award winning journalist and author.

Ms. Fink's most recent success and the topic of her GREAT Day Keynote is her book *Five Days at Memorial: Life and Death in a Storm-Ravaged Hospital*. Originally written as an article published by the New York Times Magazine, it investigates the deadly choices faced in a New Orleans hospital during the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina. Since its publication it has won the Pulitzer Prize for Investigative Reporting as well as named a New York Times Top 10 Book for 2013.



Success didn't just find her overnight, however. Ms. Fink has been a long time humanitarian, with a passion for issues in war and medicine. Even while studying medicine and neuroscience at Stanford, she investigated the Nazi Holocaust and protested genocide in Bosnia. She has used her expertise and experiences to share her knowledge and has taught classes at Harvard, Tulane and the New School.

Ms. Fink is a 1990 graduate of the University of Michigan and received her M.D. and Ph.D. from Stanford University. Her reporting has won the Pulitzer Prize, the National Magazine Award, and the Overseas Press Club Lowell Thomas Award, among other journalism prizes. She has had articles appear in a number of high profile publications such as the New York Times, Discover, and Scientific America.
