Update on Reported Burglaries to Saratoga Townhouses

The University Police Department (UPD) continues to investigate reports from residents of the Saratoga Townhouses regarding burglaries to their residences. UPD has conducted numerous interviews of members of both the College and external communities and has followed-up on numerous leads generated from those conversations. The investigation into the reported cases continues to move forward.

UPD reminds faculty, staff and students to remain vigilant at all times and take the following actions to help ensure their own safety:

- Be aware of your surroundings and travel in pairs or groups when possible.

- Students and employees are reminded that suspicious activity taking place on campus should be reported to UPD. Pre-program the number for UPD into your cell phone for use in an emergency in order to expedite your call: (585) 245-5222. Calls to 9-1-1 from a non-campus phone go to the Livingston County Sheriff's Office Emergency Communications and Dispatch Center.
- Request an on-campus escort 24 hours a day by calling UPD at (585) 245-5222.
