The following timely warning to the campus is being provided by the University Police Department as required by the Jeane Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Police and Campus Crime Statistics Act.

On Sunday Feb. 17, 2019 at approximately 3 a.m., the Village of Geneseo police responded to a report of an unknown male who entered the Alpha Kappa Phi sorority residence located at 26 Wadsworth Street in the Village of Geneseo.

The suspect is described as a white male, in his 40's, with a muscular build, short salt and pepper colored hair, possible facial hair, and wearing a grey sweatshirt. The investigation of this incident is continuing.
