Unlimited Dining

Retail Dollars

[Retail dollars](#) can be used at any of our retail locations (Starbucks, Market North, Mary's, and Jack's) as well as our vending machines. Retail locations work on a declining balance. Students can add more retail dollars to their meal plan at any time.

Campus Cash

A [Campus Cash](#) account is an optional, prepaid account that can be used at any on-campus restaurant or café, all retail locations, on-campus vending machines, and several local off-campus businesses (Mama Mia's, Byrne Dairy, and Subway). This debit-style account provides an easy and secure way to manage spending.

Changes to Your Meal Plan

We offer three unlimited dining plans for on-campus students. Your meal plan is automatically included on your college tuition bill for all students living on campus. When you receive your bill, new students will automatically be enrolled in the Knight500 plan, and returning students will automatically be enrolled in the Knight250 plan. Students living off-campus who have previously enrolled in a meal plan will see your plan automatically added to your tuition bill.
