

Map Description

1. Check-In Starts at Lot I

- **Location:** Located in the southern part of campus, near the **College Stadium**.
- **Action:** This is the "First Stop" for Housing Check-In and picking up ID cards.
- **Transition:** After checking in at Lot I, you will be directed to one of two color-coded routes (Green or Red) based on your residence hall.

2. The Green Route (North & Central Villages)

If your hall is on this list, follow the **green** signs and arrows.

Residence Halls served:

- **North Village:** Seneca (91), Ontario (101), Genesee (25), Erie (81), and Putnam (53).
- **Central Village:** Allegany (57), Wyoming (49), Monroe (73), Jones (31), and Steuben (61).

Unloading Process:

- Look for the **"X"** symbol (Welcome Zone) at your specific building.
- **Rule:** The driver must remain in the vehicle at all times.
- **Long-term Parking:** Once unloaded, move your car immediately to **Lots F, R, E, H, or Q** (located on the western/left side of the map).

3. The Red Route (South Village)

If your hall is on this list, follow the **red** signs and arrows.

Residence Halls served:

- Onondaga (40), Nassau (90), Niagara (17), Saratoga Terrace (61), Suffolk (70), and Wayne (50).

Unloading Process:

- Look for the **"X"** symbol (Welcome Zone) at your specific building.
- **Rule:** The driver must remain in the vehicle at all times.

- **Long-term Parking:** Once unloaded, move your car immediately to **Lots U, T, or TT** (located in the southeastern/bottom right area near the stadium).

4. Important Rules & Contact

- **Emergency:** Contact University Police at (585) 245-5222.
- **Traffic Flow:** Most campus roads are converted to one-way traffic during move-in. Specifically, Red Jacket Drive near the South Village is a loop that exits onto Route 20A.
- **Unloading Zones:** You may only stop at the designated "Welcome Tents" (marked with an X) to drop off belongings; these are not parking spots.
