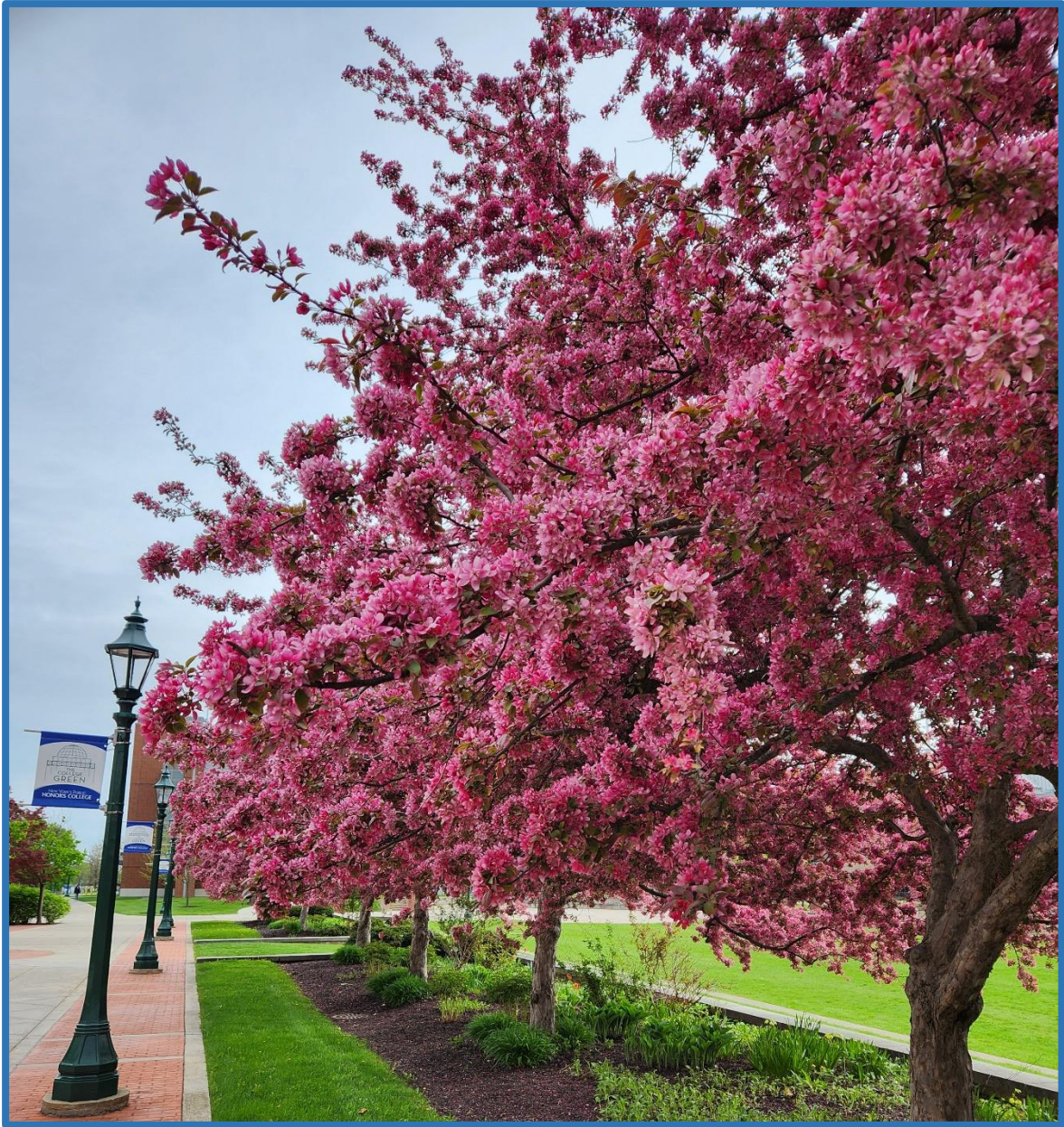

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Comments on the 2025-26 Annual Report of the Office of Sponsored Research

Traditional Funding Activities: In 2025-26 we reached \$3,140,020 for total new awards, which was the result of 18 awards to 26 faculty PIs and co-PIs in 9 academic departments and 4 offices. This is the 4th highest dollar amount of annual awards in the last 26 years. During the 2025-26-year, 49 faculty and staff members in 24 departments/offices submitted 41 proposals totaling \$20,513,878 in requests. Total grant expenditures for our 35 active Research Foundation for SUNY projects reached \$2,696,976; --our highest amount ever. This is the fifth year in a row that our Research Foundation for SUNY expenditures have exceeded \$2 million.

Access Opportunity Programs (AOP) successfully renewed the TRIO Student Support Services grant and had continuing support from the New York State Education Department's Collegiate Science and Technology Entry Program (CSTEP) and TRIO Ronald E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement program. AOP and the Career Design Center also received a SUNY EOP HIPs: Paid Internship Scale-Up Initiative award. The Career Design Center also had AmeriCorps funding through the NY State Office of Children and Family Services and a SUNY award for workforce development.

The Biology Department was awarded new funds from SUNY Brockport/Livingston County Board of Supervisors and had continuing support from the National Science Foundation (NSF) through the Research in Undergraduate Institutions (RUI), Building Research Capacity in Biology (BRC-BIO), Research Coordination Networks in Undergraduate Biology Education (RCN-UBE), and Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics Program (S-STEM) programs.

School of Business faculty members received new awards from the University of California Riverside/Kauffman Foundation and the Spencer Educational Foundation.

The Department of Chemistry & Biochemistry received an NSF Enabling Partnerships to Increase Innovation Capacity (EPIIC) grant award and had continuing support from the NSF IUSE: Innovation in Two-Year College STEM Education (ITYC) program.

The School of Education received year 1 extension and year 2 funding awards from the Library of Congress as well as ongoing support from the United Way of Greater Rochester and the Finger Lakes and EnCompass Resources for Learning for the Soaring Stars Summer Program.

The Department of Geological, Environmental, and Planetary Sciences received a new award from NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center and had continued NSF research support and Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship Program support.

The History Department received a new award from the Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation and had ongoing support from the Mellon Foundation.

The Department of Philosophy and the Department of Political Science & International Relations collaborated to receive two America 250 grants and a Constitution Day Event award from the Jack Miller Center. A faculty member in Political Science and International relations was awarded an American Political Science Association Congressional Fellowship.

The Department of Physics and Astronomy received continuing support from the U.S. Department of Energy through the University of Rochester's Laboratory for Laser Energetics and had continuing support from Cornell University through the NASA Space Grant program and from the NSF Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship and Research in Undergraduate Institutions (RUI) programs.

The College of Arts and Sciences received a SUNY Gateway Course Success Faculty Learning Community Program award. Computing & Information Technology and Accessibility Services received a SUNY EIT Accessibility Grant. The Office of Diversity and Equity had continuing support from the U.S. Department of Justice. Milne Library had continued support from the N.Y. State Education Department for Library Collection Aid. The Office of the Provost received a SUNY Community of Practice for Embedding Industry Credentials into Academic Coursework award and a Summer Program

Joint Funding Opportunity grant to support the 2026 Soaring Stars program. The Teaching and Learning Center received Google funding through the EmpireAI Consortium.

During 2025-26 we continued our relationship with McAllister & Quinn (M&Q), whose staff members worked with us on proposals submitted to the Arnold and Mabel Beckman Foundation's Beckman Scholars program, the Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education (U.S. Dept. of Education) Special Projects program and to the National Science Foundation's Improving Undergraduate STEM Education, Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics Program (S-STEM), and Growing Research Access for Nationally Transformative Economic Development (GRANTED) programs.

Internal Funding: In collaboration with the Geneseo Foundation, the Research Foundation for SUNY, and the Offices of Accounting and Sponsored Programs Administration, the Research Council reviewed applications from faculty members and students that resulted in 455 individual awards with a total value of \$374,257. Total internal funding for our formal grant and fellowship programs, combined with other planned support for research and scholarly activities, amounted to \$427,689.

GREAT Day: On April 22, 2026, we held a milestone event—the 20th annual GREAT Day. GREAT Day was administered by Faculty Chair Lytton Smith, Department of English & Creative Writing, Faculty Co-Chair Pallavi Panda, School of Business, Andrea Klein, Director of Campus Scheduling & Event Management, Paige Wasilewski, Coordinator of Scheduling & Events Management, Kierstyn Hager '26, and Anne Baldwin, Director of Sponsored Research. The Music Festival was coordinated by Kara Cornell, Department of Performing Arts. Alexis Clifton, Director of the Teaching and Learning Center, and Daniel Ross, Head of Access Services for Milne Library, coordinated the opening reception. We utilized the conference platform Oxford Abstract again this year, which was used for abstract submissions, event scheduling, and the online program for attendees. We also provided CAS gift cards to participants in lieu of the traditional buffet lunch.

The 20th annual GREAT Day was a wonderful success and we were particularly happy that Jack '76 and Carol '76 Kramer could be with to celebrate. GREAT Day 2026 was significantly larger than last year's event, with a total of 782 students participating in 207 session presentations, 172 poster presentations, and 19 art, music, musical theatre, film, and other special presentations under the mentorship of 134 faculty/staff sponsors and session chairs. 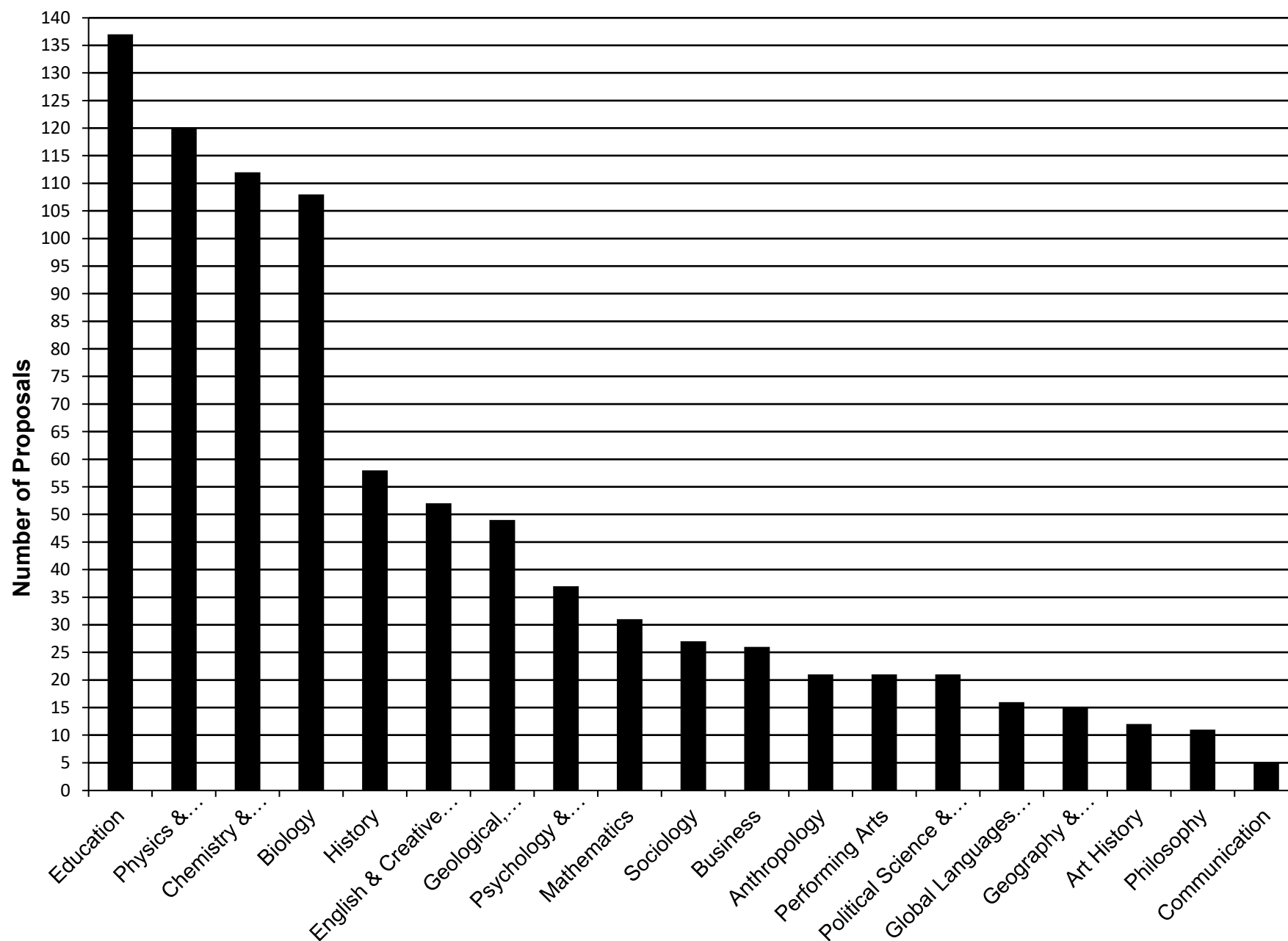

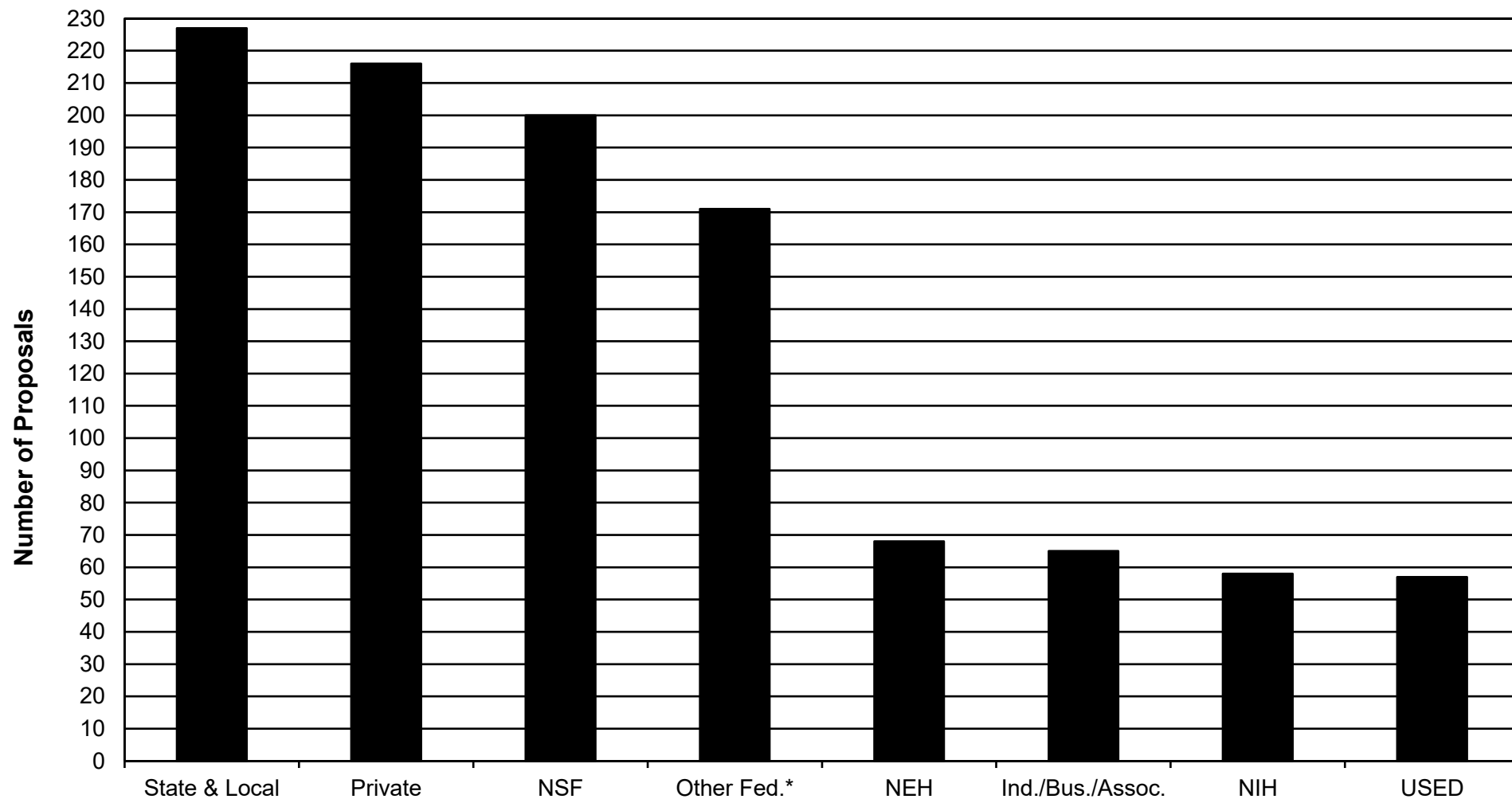

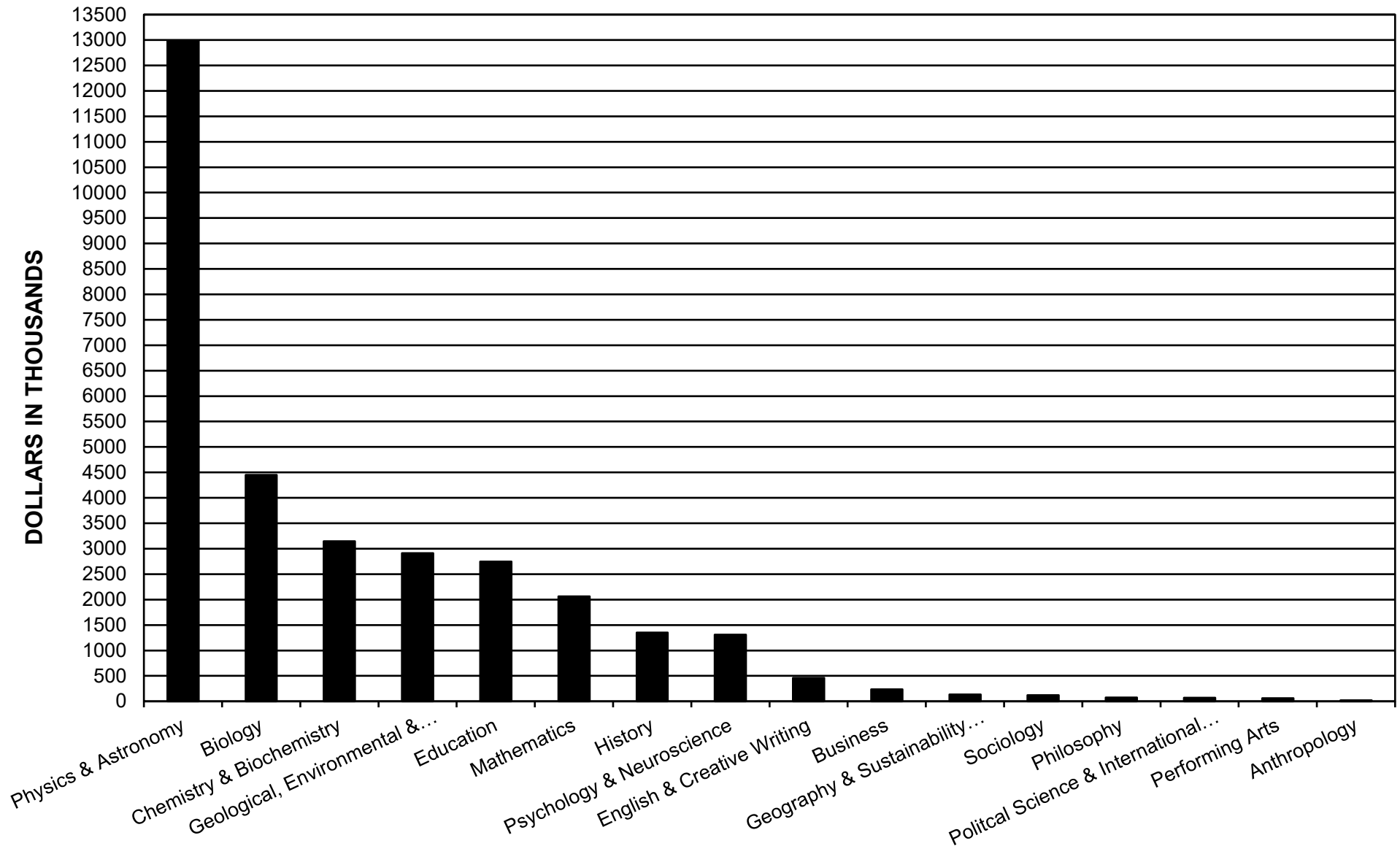

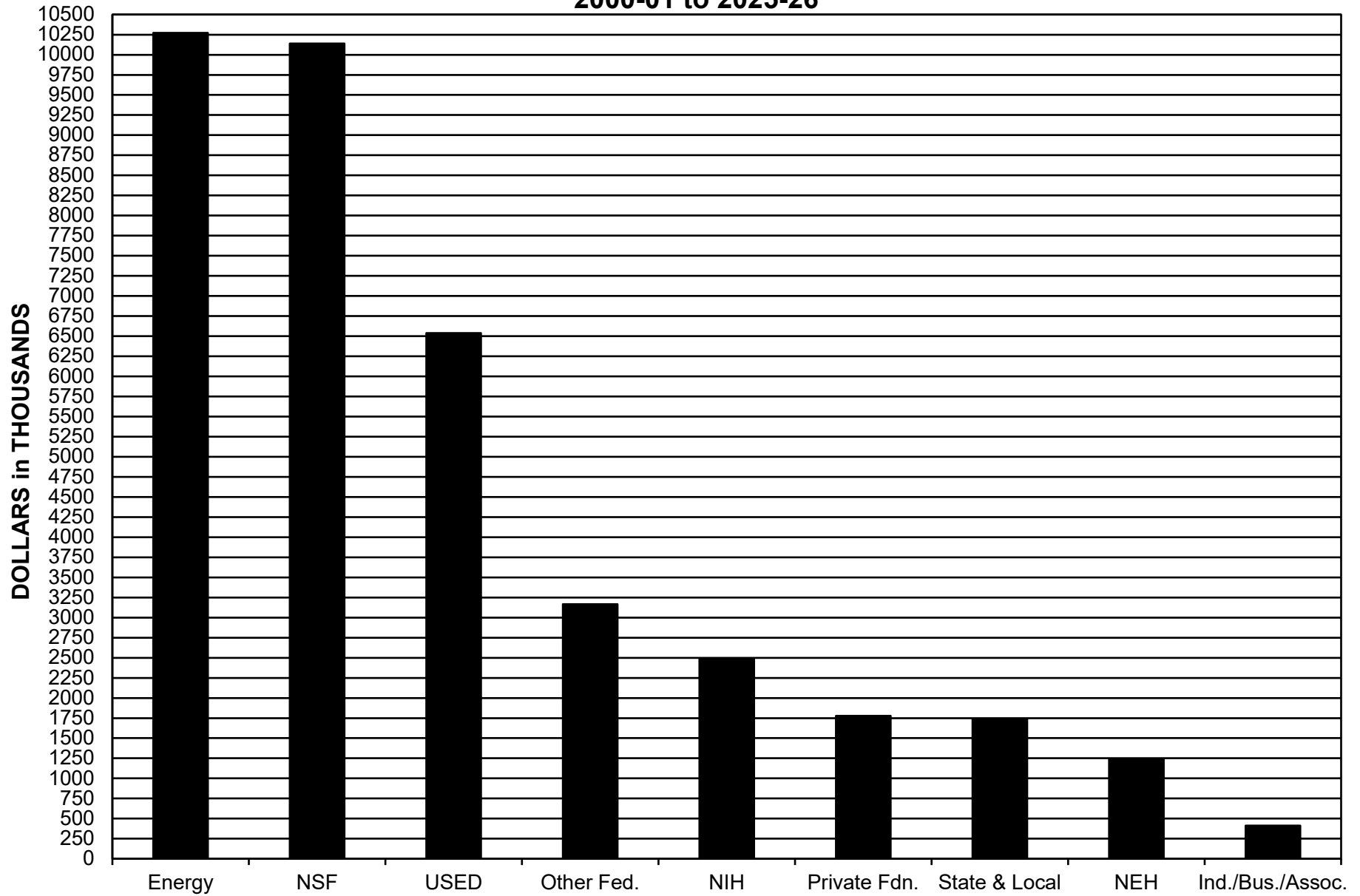

RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS 2025-26

The Research Council offers a wide range of programs to support research development and scholarly and creative activity.

Programs for Faculty Members

- **Presidential Summer Fellowships** provide untenured faculty with an opportunity to participate in scholarly activities and establish an ongoing research program. Up to six \$3,500 stipends are awarded annually from funds provided by the College.
- **Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships and the Roemer Summer Fellowship** support the research and creative projects of faculty who have been awarded tenure. These fellowships are intended to enable completion of a significant project or to embark in a new direction. The \$4,000 Geneseo Foundation Summer Fellowships are funded by the Geneseo Foundation, and the \$5,000 Roemer award is supported by an endowment gift to the Geneseo Foundation from the late Dr. Spencer Roemer.
- **Proposal Writing Support Awards** provide full-time faculty members with time and other forms of support to write proposals requesting at least \$15,000 in funding for submission to external funding agencies. Faculty members may request support for the writing of either: 1) new proposals, or 2) significant revisions of previously submitted proposals. Support will be considered for major proposals in all academic fields and for a variety of initiatives (e.g. fellowships, research grants, or educational grants). The maximum individual award is \$4,145, one course reassignment, or \$2,500 for summer salary. Collaborative submissions are also supported. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Research Development Awards** provide support for a wide variety of needs associated with developing research and scholarly projects. Maximum award is \$1,000 or one course reassignment. Funded by the College.
- **Indirect Cost Return Awards** return part of the indirect costs to the project director for research expenses not covered by budgeted costs. Funded by the College.
- **Incentive Grants** are intended to encourage and support faculty initiatives in research and to fund pilot studies, completion of manuscripts, data analyses, bibliographic or archival searches, and creative work. Travel to archives, libraries, and laboratories is also supported. Awards are limited to \$1,000, but faculty may request an additional \$500 to support the cost of involving a student in the proposed project. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Faculty Travel Grants** are made to participants in professional meetings. Maximum annual awards are \$1,000 for travel within the U.S. (excluding Hawaii) and Canada, and \$1,200 for travel to Hawaii or outside the U.S. and Canada. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Pre-Tenure Faculty Research Support Awards** were established to assist tenure-track faculty whose research and scholarly work has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Tenure-track faculty who have not yet submitted their tenure package are eligible for a base amount of \$250, but may request an additional \$250 if needed. Total award amounts are generally limited to \$500, but if program funds remain after two deadlines, then an additional deadline is announced. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Page Charge** allocations cover the costs of faculty publications in journals with mandatory page charges. Funded by the College.

Programs for Students

- **Undergraduate Travel, Research, and Creativity (TRAC) Grants** support student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester or \$1,800 per group per semester. Funded by the Student Association and the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Dr. Denise Battles and Dr. Michael Mills Endowment for Student Research Awards** recognize exemplary applications to the TRAC Grants program. All applications to the TRAC Grants program will be considered for these awards, which will be given instead of a TRAC Grant. Similarly to TRAC Grants, maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester or summer (\$1,800 maximum per groups of three or more students). They are funded by an endowment created by Dr. Denise Battles and Dr. Michael Mills.
- **Graduate Student Research and Travel Grants** support graduate student research and conference participation in conjunction with a faculty member. Maximum awards are \$600 per student per semester. Funded by the College.
- **The Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes Research Award** supports undergraduate student research or field study. Preference is given to scholarly research combining a natural science and a social science such as biology/sociology or geology/ anthropology. The awardee is chosen from among successful Geneseo Foundation Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship and Geneseo Foundation Research Assistantship applicants. The maximum award is \$600. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Dr. Wendell and Barbara Rhodes.
- **Dean Johnston and Geneseo Foundation Student Research Assistantships** provide faculty members with research assistants for their scholarly projects. Undergraduate students receive a stipend of \$1,000. Funded through an endowment established by CPAC, Inc.
- **Undergraduate Summer Fellowships** provide a \$3,000 (full-time) or \$1,000 (part-time) stipend for students to undertake a research or creative project under the direction of a faculty member. Students must devote to their project either two consecutive summer months of effort for full-time awards or approximately 3 weeks (which may be spread across the summer) for part-time awards. Funded by the Geneseo Foundation.
- **Jason and Diana Kyrwood '95 Student/Faculty Research Endowed Fellowship in Honor of Ellen Kintz** provides \$2,500 plus an additional \$500 (\$3,000 total) for a stipend for an undergraduate student to work with a faculty member in the social sciences on an existing research project. Recipients must devote two consecutive summer months to the project. Funded through the Geneseo Foundation by an endowment established by Jason and Diana Kyrwood in honor of emerita faculty member Ellen Kintz.

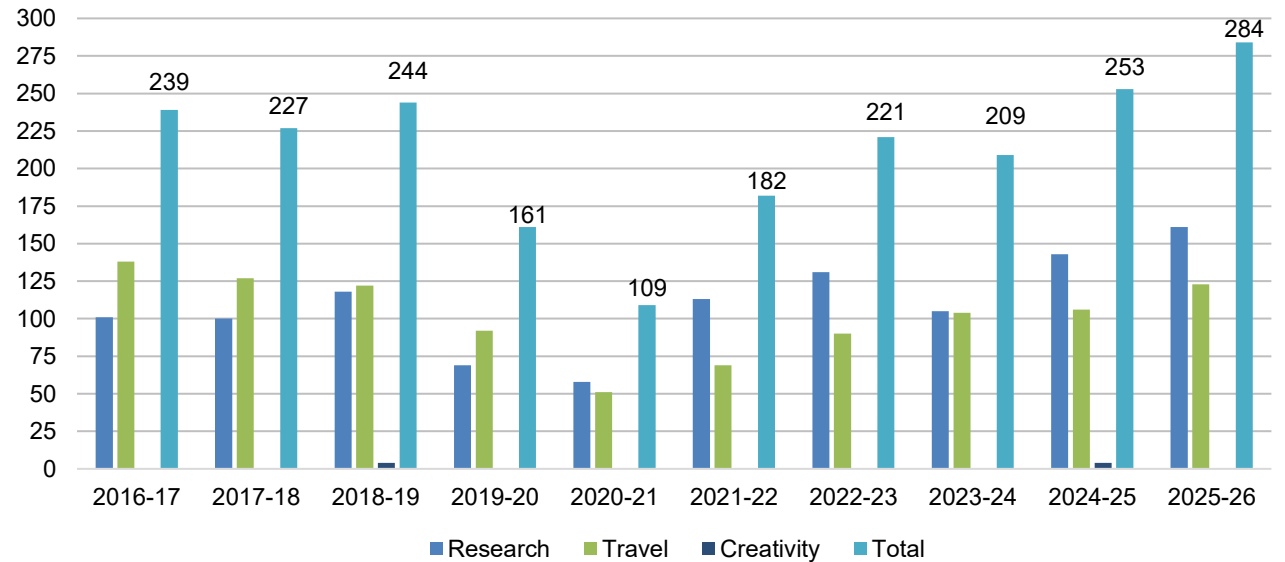

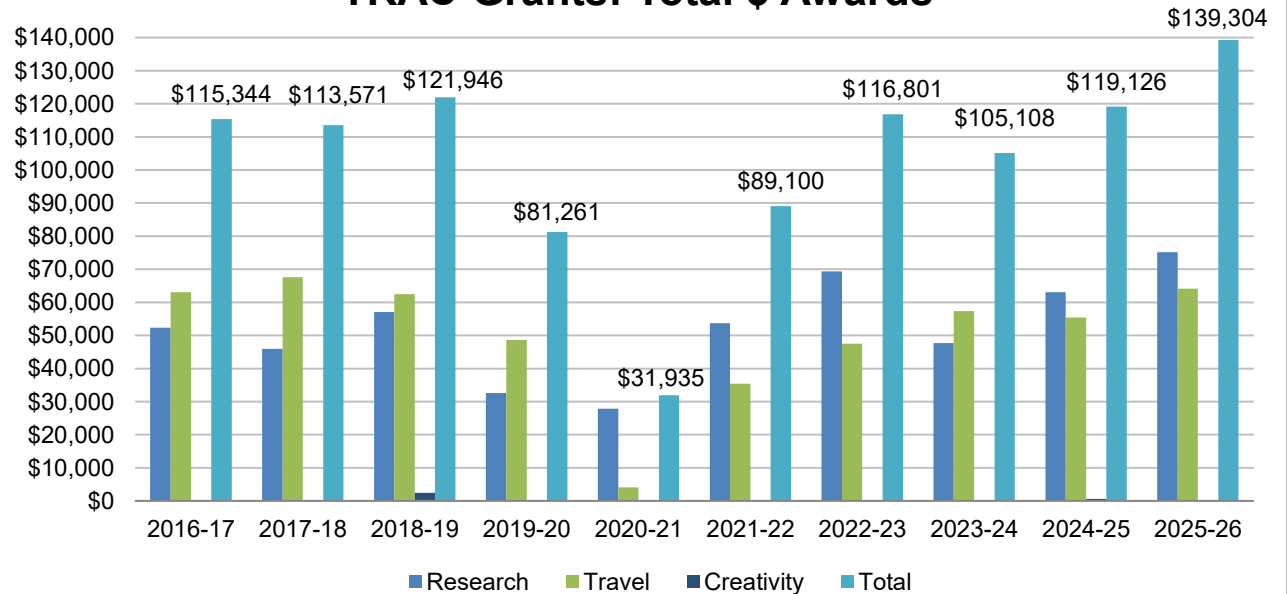

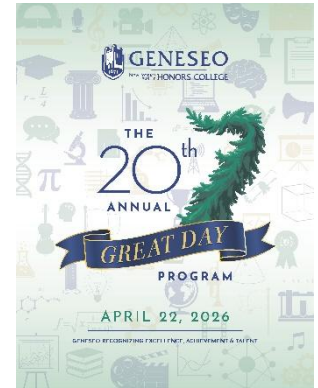
